
## Sources of Information on the Vegetation and Flora of Western Australia

It is recommended that users who need more specialised information on the lower plants should consult the Library and Information Service of Western Australia for such publications.

Journals in which taxonomic information on the Western Australian flora is published have not been fully listed. Green (1985) should be consulted for specific references to particular genera.

As publications on the Western Australian flora are appearing at an increasing rate, this list cannot be fully up to date. More specific information should be sought from the Library and Information Service of Western Australia.
