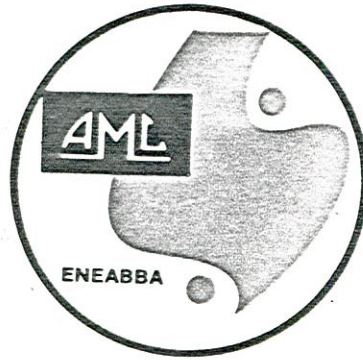

Appointed to present position, October 1983. Previously spent 10 years farming in wet and dry lands in Western Australia.

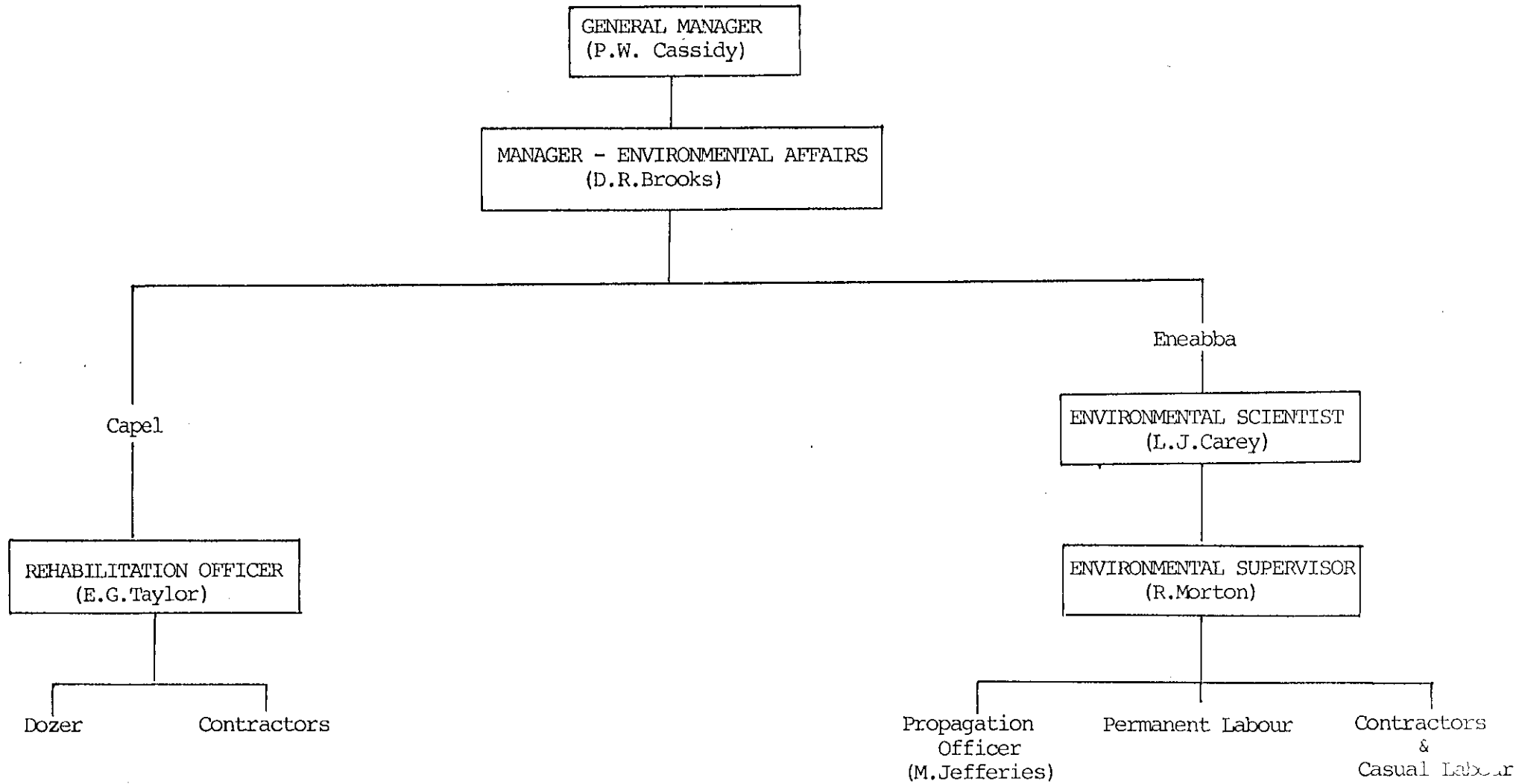
PROPAGATION OFFICER

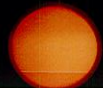
