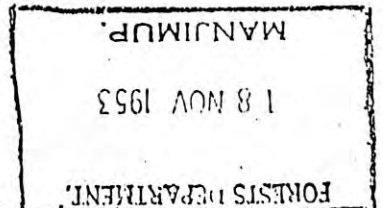

## LITTER FALL INVESTIGATION.

AIM.

The purpose of this investigation is to gain knowledge of the annual litter fall in the Wandoo and Mallet forests as compared with the Jarraa Forest.

O.I.C. A.D.P.O. Hatch.

DATE OF INAUGURATION. 1.11.1953.

LOCATION.

Wandoo Forest. Mt. Saddleback area. Loc. 10930.  
Mallet Forest. Dryandra. South Block.  
or Lol. Gray. (South 4 or Lol Gray B.).

METHOD.

Leaf trays (2' x 2') will be set out at 1 chain intervals in the two areas, along random strip lines one chain apart.

The litter will be collected weekly and dried out at Dwellingup.

A crown plan will be prepared for each area, and the canopy cover calculated.

LIST OF INVESTIGATIONS.

1. The total amount of litter being deposited in the Wandoo and Mallet forest during the year.
2. The composition of the litter. (Leaves, twigs, fruit and bark).
3. The variation in litter fall during the year.

INITIAL ACTION.

The leaf trays are to be set out during the period (26 - 30) - 10 - 1953.

SUBSEQUENT ACTION.

The trays to be collected 1.12.1953 and on the 1st of
