


- 70% of all newspapers are now recycled. This has increased from 28% in 1990 and you can help make it even higher;
- all standard newsprint
   manufactured in Australia has a
   recycled content of up to 55%
   because of your part in recycling.



Be waste wise. If your council does not collect papers, they make excellent mulch by placing the paper between your plants in layers two centimetres thick and covering with soil.
