- (b) Under reasonable circumstances the license holder shall, when called upon to do so, personally show any wildlife officer or officer of the Forests Department any area from which *Boronia megastigma* and *Boronia heterophylla* sprays have been taken by the license holder.
- (c) All sprays of *Boronia megastigma* and *Boronia heterophylla* must be cut from the plant with a knife or secateurs and not broken off. Each plant must be left with the bottom two lateral branches and under no circumstances be removed from the ground. - (e) The licensee shall observe and comply with the provisions of the Bush Fires Act 1954 (as amended) and any Regulations made under that Act.

FOREST PRODUCE (BORONIA) LICENSE

Time
This is to certify that KEITH HARRIS & CO. LTD. of 3 BOOKHAM STREET, MORLEY (hereinafter referred to as "the Licensee") is hereby licensed from the FIRST day of JULY 1979 to the THIRTY FIRST day of OCTOBER 1979 to collect Boronia megastigma blossom on and from the area described in the schedule hereto under and subject to the provisions of the Forests Act, 1918 and the Regulations thereunder and in force for the time being. This license is granted subject to the following special conditions -

1. The Licensee shall pay to the Conservator of Forests (hereinafter called "the Conservator") at the office of the Forests Department Perth the royalty of Fifty cents (50c) for each and every kilogram of Boronia megastigma blossom obtained under this license and such royalty shall be payable forthwith as accounts are rendered by or on behalf of the Conservator to the Licensee.

X 2. All flowers of Boronia megastigma obtained by the Licensee from Crown Land and private property during the period of this license shall be obtained by orders placed by the Licensee or its agents with pickers and not otherwise.

X 3. All orders shall be placed in writing by the Licensee or its agents and shall provide that-

3.1 The area where operations are to be carried out shall be indicated on the order.

3.2 All blossom shall be combed and delivered to the Licensee's agent.

3.3 Deliveries of blossom obtained by virtue of the order must be completed by October 31, 1979.

3.4 The gathering of the said flowers shall be carried out in such a manner that the plants shall not be destroyed or unnecessarily mutilated.

3.5 The holder of the order shall when called upon to do so personally conduct and show any officer of the Forests Department the area from which any flowers have been obtained by him whether from Crown Land or private property.

3.6 When blossom is delivered by the holder of an order he shall see that particulars of such blossom delivered are correctly entered on the agent's record form as described in Clause 13 hereunder and his signature shall be placed against the entry made on such forms.

3.7 The taking of sprays for the purpose of combing blossom elsewhere will not be permitted and all blossoms must be collected by combing direct from the plant.

4. The Licensee or its agent shall record and issue all pickers' orders and forward a copy of each order to the local Forest Officer immediately after issue.
5. Each picker must report to the local Forest Officer to register his order number and to obtain a permit to pick which will be endorsed with the area on which picking is approved.
6. The permit issued by the local Forest Officer will be valid only for the season in which the permit is issued and the area over which such permit is issued will not necessarily be allocated to the permit holder in any succeeding years.
7. The Licensee shall immediately after the expiration of the license furnish to the Conservator at the office of the Forests Department Perth a true return of all flowers of *Boronia megastigma* obtained under this license and such return shall be supported by agents' record forms as referred to in Clause 13 hereunder showing particulars of all *Boronia* purchased.
 - (a) from Crown Land
 - (b) from private property
8. All flowers of *Boronia megastigma* obtained by the Licensee under this license shall be utilised for the production of *Boronia* perfume.
9. The Licensee shall before the gathering of blossom is commenced in any district or centre supply the Conservator with particulars as to the full names and addresses of its agents.
10. Should it be necessary during the currency of this license to make any alteration in the agent or agents appointed as notified to the Conservator or in the event of any change of address of any agent or agents the Licensee shall notify the Conservator of such alterations without delay.
11. The price to be paid by the Licensee for blossom from Crown Lands and private property in any district shall be the same.
12. All flowers of *Boronia megastigma* obtained shall be forwarded by the agent in containers supplied by the Licensee.
13. The Licensee shall supply agents with record forms on which the agent shall enter the following information concerning all deliveries of *Boronia* blossom -

The agent shall obtain the picker's signature against the entry relating to the blossom delivered by the picker. These record forms shall at all times be open to inspection by an officer of the Forests Department and shall at the end of the season be returned to the Licensee who shall forward them to the Conservator in support of the return required under Clause 7 hereof.

- X 14. This license shall not be transferred without the consent in writing of the Conservator.
- X 15. In the event of Boronia being received from any source whatsoever from persons other than those holding an order the Conservator shall be notified of the full circumstances and no payment in respect thereof shall be made by the Licensee until authorised by the Conservator
- X 16. The Licensee when working on a proclaimed catchment area shall at all times co-operate with officers of the Metropolitan Water Supply Sewerage and Drainage Board or of the various Country Water Supply authorities and shall take such action as is required by the Conservator to minimise pollution and erosion.
- X 17. The Licensee shall observe and comply with the provisions of the "Bush Fires Act, 1954" and the amendments thereof and the regulations thereunder and in force for the time being. Any breach of the said Act and/or regulations shall be a breach of the conditions of this license.
- X 18. In default of the observance and performance by the Licensee of the conditions of this license and the observance by it of the provisions of the said Acts and Regulations or any of them to which this license is subject the Conservator may suspend this license for such time as he may think fit or by notice in writing to the Licensee cancel and determine this license.
- X 19. Any notice in writing to the Licensee may be served on it by addressing such notice to it and sending it by post to or leaving it at the Licensee's address as stated in this license.

20. If any question shall arise as to the observance and performance by the Licensee of the conditions of this license or the observance by it of the provisions of the said Acts and Regulations or in case of any dispute in relation to the gathering of flowers of *Boronia megastigma* or as to the quantity or quality of flowers obtained the same shall be decided by the Conservator whose decision shall be final.
