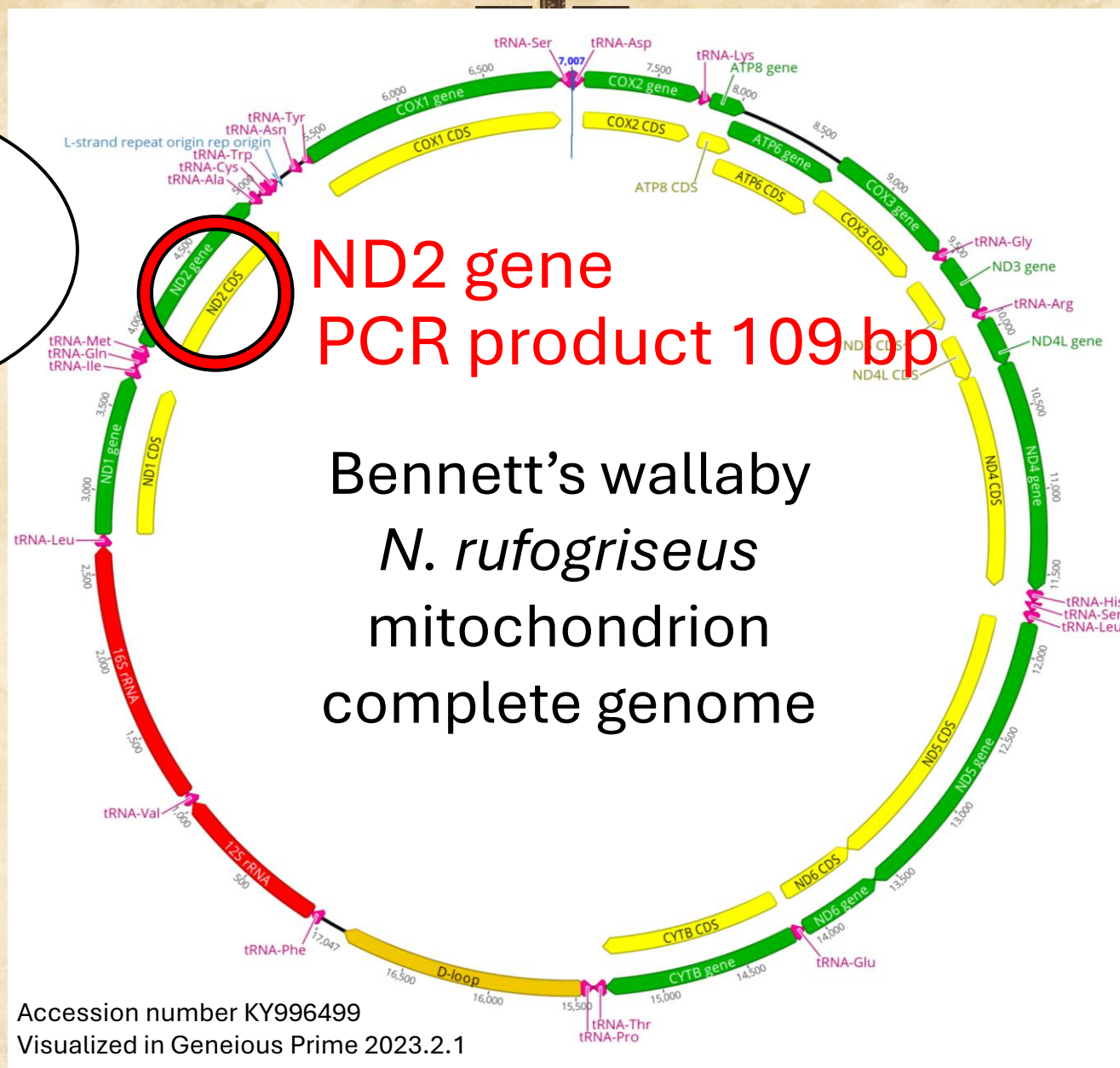


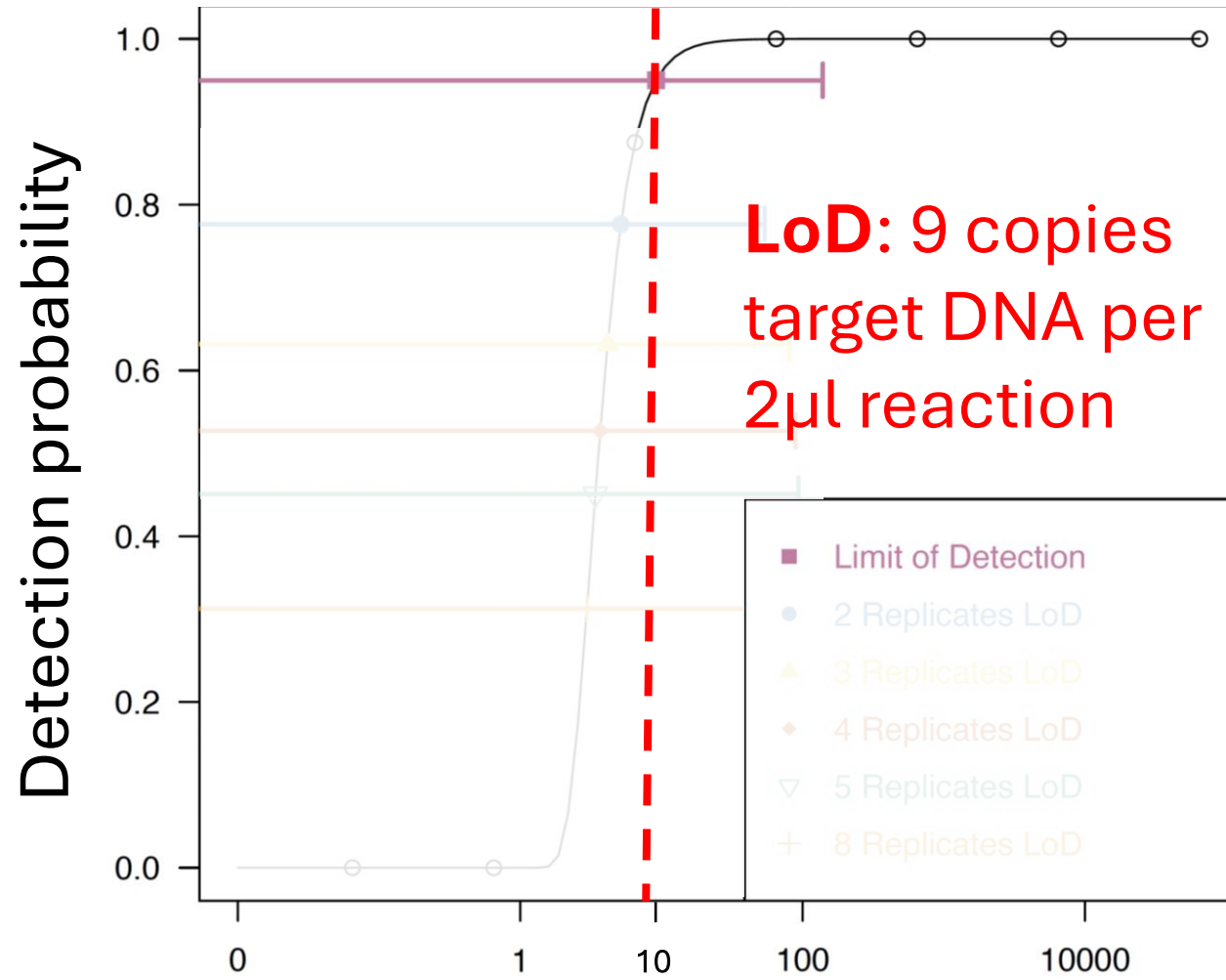
Damage caused by pest wallabies. (Left) wallaby browsing activity. (Right) wallaby-free habitat. Image credit Craig Brown.

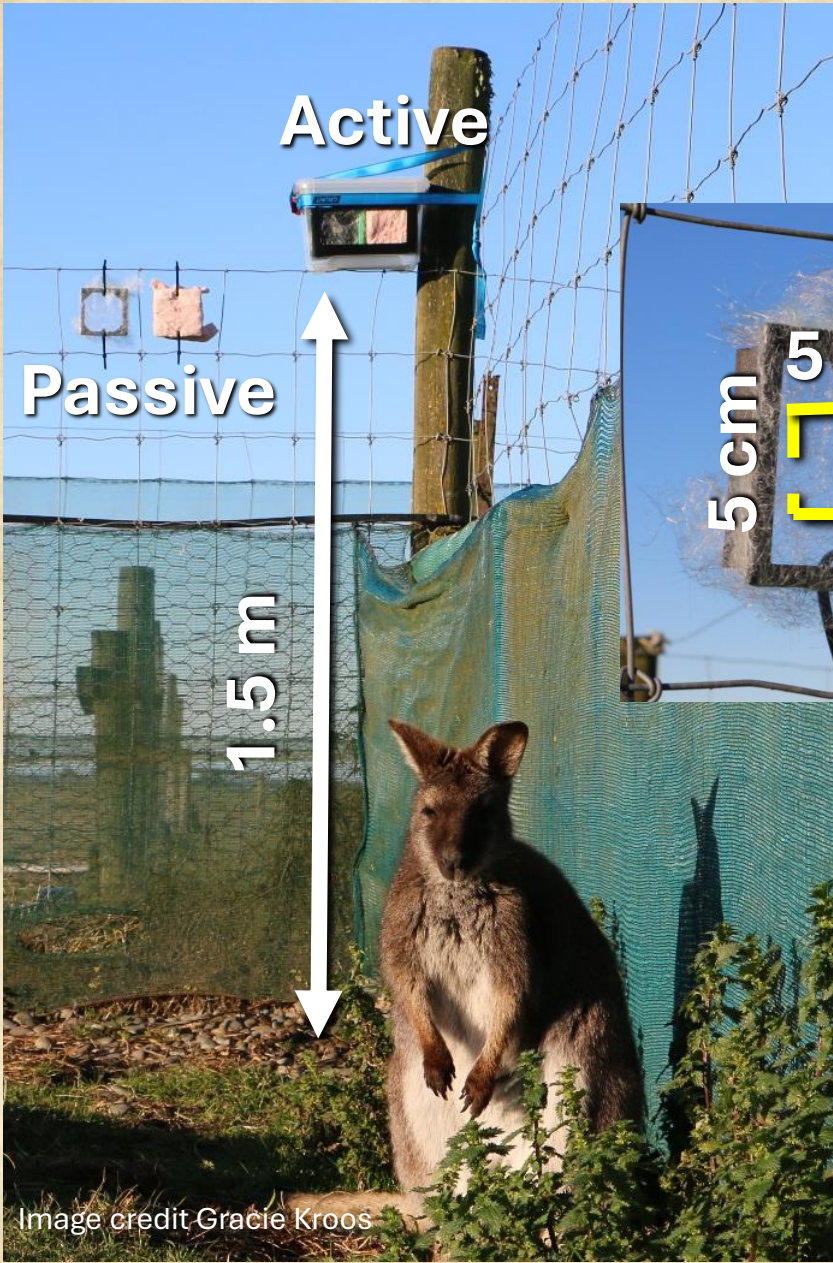
