Eucalyptus description

- accedens - Tree 9-20 m, smooth greyish/white bark.
- beardiana - Mallee 4 m, smooth grey bark.
- brachycorys - Mallee/sm tree 6 m, rough lower bark, smooth greyish upper bark.
- camaldulensis - Tree 24-30 m - smooth whitish bark.
- carnei - Tree 6 m - rough bark persistent bark trunk, yellowish smooth above.
- clelandii - Tree 6-12 m - rough persistent dark bark at base, smooth grey above.
- decipiens - sm tree/mallee 7-9 m - grey fibrous rough bark.
- dichromophloia - Tree - smooth - flakey bark.
- dongarraensis - Mallee/sm tree 2-8 m - ribbon bark lower smooth white upper.
- drummondii - Small tree 4-8 m - smooth powdery white bark.
- dundasii - Tree 9-20 m - bark rough tessellated dark then smooth reddish brown
- ebbanoensis - Mallee/sm tree 3-6 m - dark rough bark at base smooth light brown above.
- eremicola - Mallee 3 m - bark smooth grey or brown.
- eremophila - Mallee 3-6 m - cinnamon-brown smooth summer shedding.
- erythrocorys - Small tree 5-8 m - bark white & patchy.
- eudesmioides - Mallee 2-3 m - dark grey basal bark - light or yellowish-pink smooth upper.
- ewartiana - Mallee 3-6 m - smooth reddish/brown bark - rough at base.
- foecunda - Mallee/sm tree 2-9 m - bark smooth grey brown.
- gittinsii - Mallee 5 m - peeling rough bark stocking, smooth grey brown above.
- gongylocarpa - Tree 7-12 m - white bark.
- jucunda - Mallee 3.5-7 m - rough fibrous grey bark lower part.
- kingsmillii - Mallee 2-3 m - rough grey bark.
- kochii - Mallee/sm tree 2-12 m - rough grey spirally twisted persistent bark.
- leptopoda - Mallee - smooth whitish grey bark.
- lesouefii - Tree 12 m - basal bark rough, flaky, dark persistent, smooth above.
- loxophleba sub sploxophleba - Mallee tree 6 -13 m - rough persistent grey trunk bark.
- lu casii - Tree 12 m - bark rough persistent.
- macrocarpa - Straggling mallee 2 -4 m.
- mannensis - Mallee/sm tree 3-7 m - bark rough, fibrous grey deciduous, sometimes white.
- microtheca - Tree 12-20 m - smooth matt white powdery bark.
- oldfieldi - Mallee 2-6 m - bark smooth, grey brown.
- oleosa var borealis - Mallee/tree 2-12 m - bark dark grey fibrous persistent basal.
- oleosa var oleosa - Mallee/tree 3-13 m - persistent pale grey fibrous bark, basal.
- oraria - Mallee 2.7 m - smooth grey-brown bark.
- orbifolia - Mallee 3 m - smooth reddish-brown bark.
- plenissima - Mallee/tree 3 m - dark grey rough bark on lower trunk.
- polycarpa var oligocarpa - Mallee 5 m - bark persistent tessellated grey-brown.

- pyriformis - Mallee 2-4 m - branchlets shining red.
- redunea - Mallee/sm tree 1-3 m - smooth light grey-brown bark.
- rigidula - Mallee 2-6 m - ribbons of old bark accumulate at base.
- rudis - Tree 9-15 m - bark smooth & grey on upper branches.
- salubris - Tree 15-20 m - spirally-fluted, twisted or rigid trunk, bark smooth.
- striatocalyx - Mallee 3-9 m - bark dark grey fibrous at base upper smooth & whitish/
yellow.
- socialis - Mallee/tree 2-12 m - smooth pale grey strip shedding.
- tetragona - Mallee/sm tree 2-8 m - lower bark grey & flaky, smooth upper yellowish/
brown.
- todtiana - Tree 9-16 m - bark rough and prickly ashy grey-yellow.
- transcontinentalis - Tree/mallee 2 m - bark smooth white or grey.
- trivalvis - Mallee 4 m - rough basal bark smooth & pale upper.
