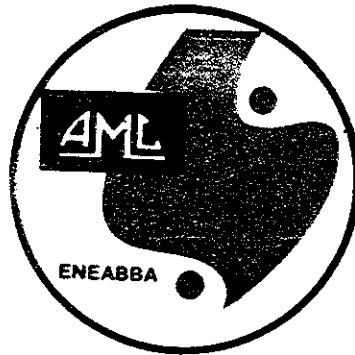

MURRAY RYALL

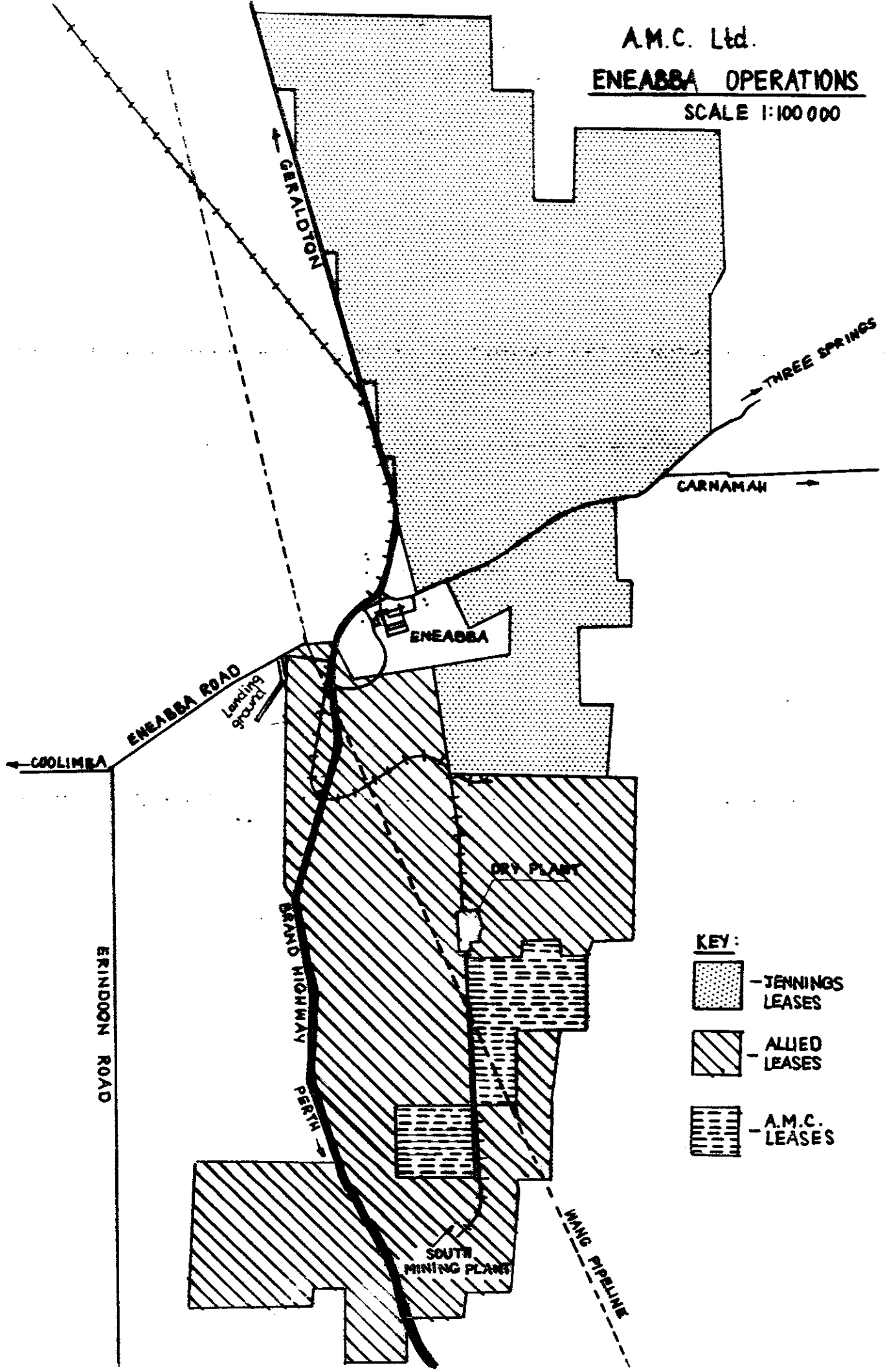
Appointed to present position, March 1986. Previously spent 3 years as Landscaping Supervisor and 2 years Rehabilitation Officer with Allied Eneabba.




PROPAGATION OFFICER
