AN ACT to amend the *Animals and Birds Protection Act 1928*. A.D. 1940.  
[17 December, 1940.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Animals and Birds Protection Act 1940*. Short title and commencement.

(2) This Act shall commence on the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and forty.

*Animals and Birds Protection.*

A.D. 1940. **2** Section seven of the Principal Act is hereby amended—

- I. By substituting the word “ten” for the word “nine” in subsection (1): and
- II. By expunging subsections (2), (3), and (4), and substituting therefor the following new subsections (2), (3), and (4) —

“(2) The Board shall consist of—

- I. The Commissioner of Police: and
- II. Nine members appointed by the Governor, of whom—
  - (a) One shall be appointed to represent the trappers and hunters of the State:
  - (b) Two shall be appointed to represent the fur-skin merchants of the State:
  - (c) One shall be appointed to represent the Tasmanian Farmers, Stock-owners, and Orchardists Association:
  - (d) One shall be appointed to represent associations or societies interested in, or concerned with, the science of zoology:
  - (e) One shall be appointed to represent the Municipal Association of Tasmania:
  - (f) One shall be appointed to represent the Game Protection and Acclimatisation Association of Tasmania:
  - (g) One shall be such person as the Governor determines: and
  - (h) One shall be appointed by the Tasmanian Producers Organisation.

“(3) Each appointed member of the Board shall, subject to this Act, hold office for a term of three years.

“(4) At the first meeting of the Board in each year, commencing with the year one thousand nine hundred and forty-one, the members of the Board shall appoint one of their number to be the Chairman of the Board during that year.”.

Transitory  
provisions.

**3** On the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and forty, the appointed members of the Board holding office at that date shall cease to hold office, and shall be replaced by the appointment of the members as provided by subsection (2) of section seven as enacted by this Act, who shall hold office as from the first day of January, one thousand nine hundred and forty-one.
