

COMMON FUNGAL GROUPS - BASIDIOMYCETES



AGARICS
Mushrooms with gills



SPINE FUNGI
Mushrooms or fruit bodies with spines



BOLETES
Mushrooms with pores



TRUFFLE-LIKE FUNGI
Underground fruiting fungi



CORAL FUNGI
Fruit bodies with simple club-like or multi-branched structures



LEATHER SHELF AND CRUST FUNGI
Thin leathery shelves or sheets on sticks and wood



PUFFBALLS
Sac-like fungi



POLYPORES
Firm or hard woody bracket-like fungi on wood and trees

STINKHORNS →
Delicate or firm with foul smelling slime



JELLY FUNGI
Soft gelatinous fungi on wood

COMMON FUNGAL GROUPS - ASCOMYCETES



CUP FUNGI
Cup- or disc-shaped fruit bodies



MORELS
Fleshy fruit bodies with an elongated honeycomb-like



EARTH TONGUES
Firm and fleshy with a tongue-like appearance



FLASK FUNGI
Usually hard and carbon-like
