An Act relating to the *Vermin Destruction Act 1890.*

[23rd December, 1901.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

1. This Act may for all purposes be cited as the *Vermin Destruction Act 1901*, and shall be construed as one with the *Vermin Destruction Act 1890*. Short title and construction.

2. In section three of the *Vermin Destruction Act 1890* the interpretation of the word "owner" shall be deemed and taken to include any person who is for the time being the grantee or holder of a grazing licence under section one hundred and twenty-three of the *Land Act 1890*. Meaning of "owner."

3. In section fifty-nine of the *Vermin Destruction Act 1890* for the words "across any such road or elsewhere" there shall be substituted the words "pursuant to this or the last preceding section." Amendment of s. 59 of No. 1153. *Ross v. Hill*, 23 A.L.T. 35.

4. In section fifteen of the *Vermin Destruction Act* 1890 for the word "necessary" wherever occurring there shall be substituted the words "practicable and reasonable."

5. In section fifteen of the *Vermin Destruction Act* 1890 the words "less than Two pounds nor" and the words "less than Ten pounds nor" are hereby repealed wherever they occur.
