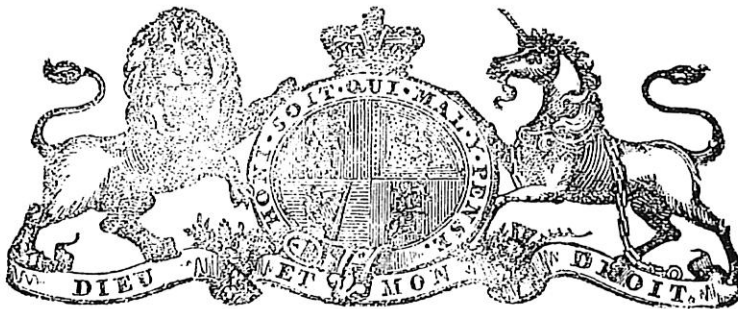

An Act to amend an Act intituled "*An Act to Protect Game.*" [17th December 1872.]

**W**HEREAS it is expedient to amend the Act No. CCCXI. intituled "*An Act to protect Game*": Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

Preamble.

1. This Act shall be called and may be cited as the "*Amended Game Act 1872.*"

Title of Act.

2. That from and after the passing of this Act the owner or occupier of any land may at any time kill or destroy hares being on the land owned or occupied by him; and may grant permission to any person with dogs to enter in and upon such lands and kill or destroy hares thereon.

Owners or occupiers of land may destroy hares thereon.

3. If any person shall wilfully trespass on any land not being Crown land in search or pursuit of game, on complaint of the owner or occupier of such land and on conviction before any two justices, he shall forfeit and pay a sum not exceeding Ten pounds, and having in his possession implements for shooting, or being accompanied by dogs shall be *prima facie* evidence of the purpose of such trespass.

Persons trespassing on private lands in search of game liable to a penalty of Ten pounds.
