**Remnant vegetation at Yilliminning Rock**

Yilliminning Rock is a substantial granite outcropping or hill (~4ha) located east of Narrogin. A rich diversity of flora can be found in kwongan and woodland communities on or around the rock, which is located in a 25 ha 'C' class reserve. Many vegetation types including at least 75 plant *species (ID of collection not finished)* are recorded from the reserve. This is a significant local remnant, found in an area cleared for agriculture. A management plan is required for Yilliminning Rock Reserve, which is vested in the Shire of Narrogin, a popular local recreational area.
