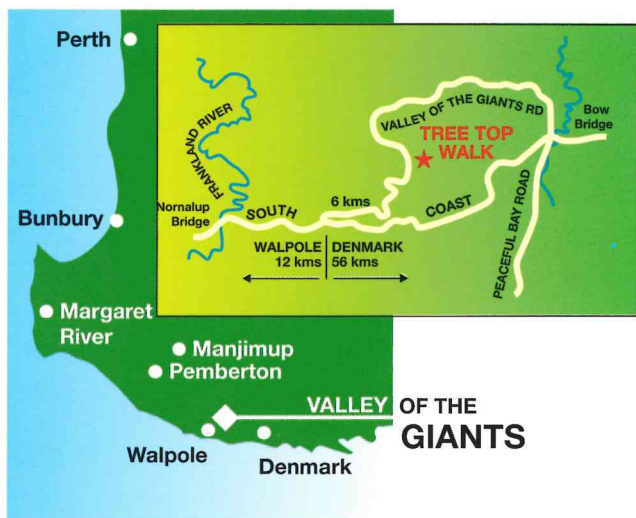
Walk through the tree tops of our unique tingle forest
