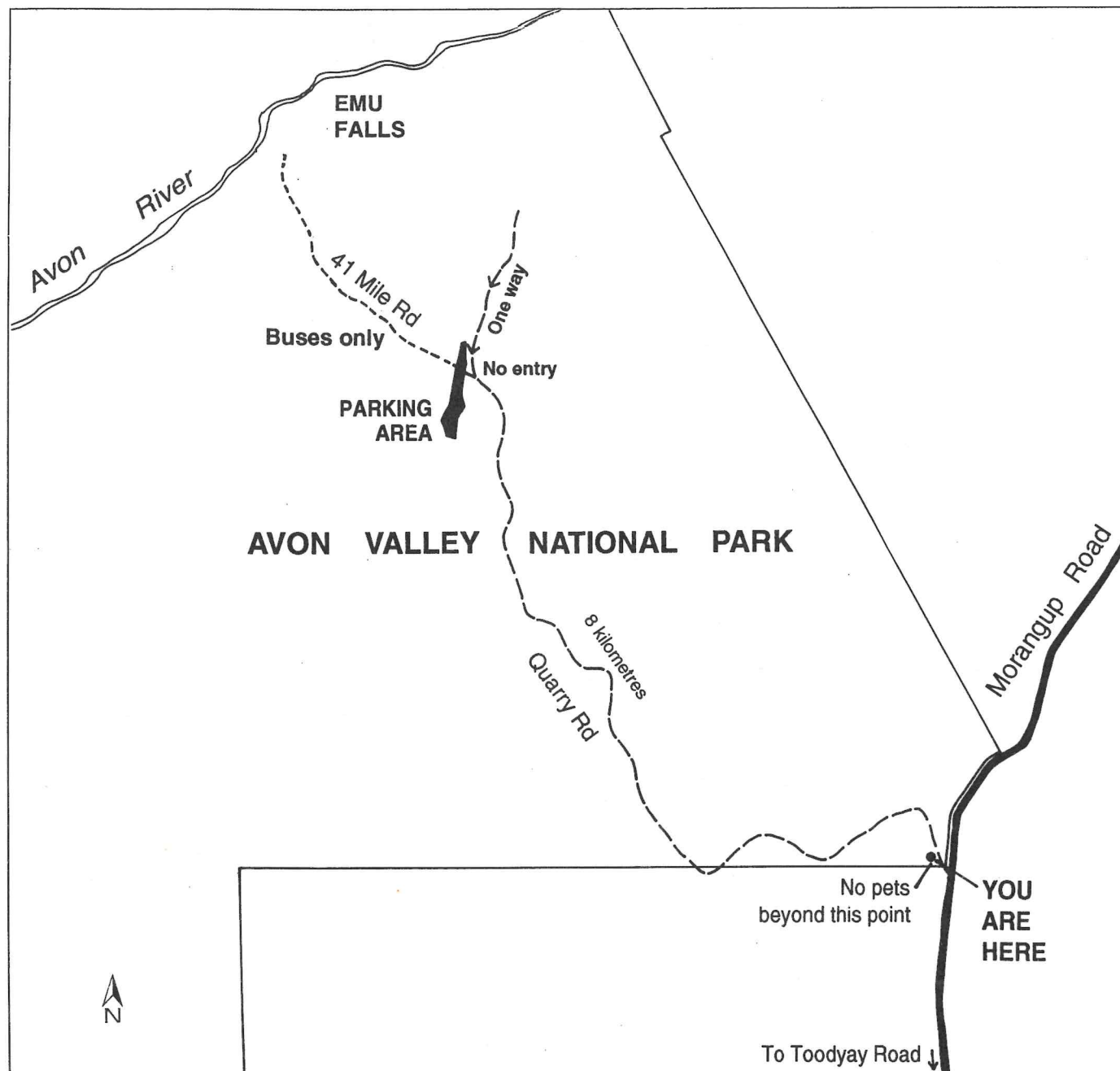

HOW TO SEE The Avon Descent

These are the special parking and traffic arrangements in place for today:

- There is a parking area provided. There is a charge of \$6 for all parking — proceeds go to the Toodyay Scouts.
- Buses will take you down to within 300 m of the river. There is no charge for the bus ride.
- You cannot continue to drive along Quarry Road past the turnoff for 41 Mile road as this is one-way traffic for today.
- Please keep your speed below 60 km/h and watch for oncoming traffic.
- There is food and drink for sale at the parking area and near the river.
- Please take your rubbish home or use the bins provided.
- **Pets are not allowed** in Avon Valley National Park even if you intend to keep them in your vehicle.
