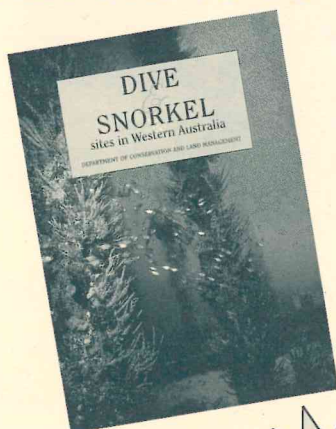

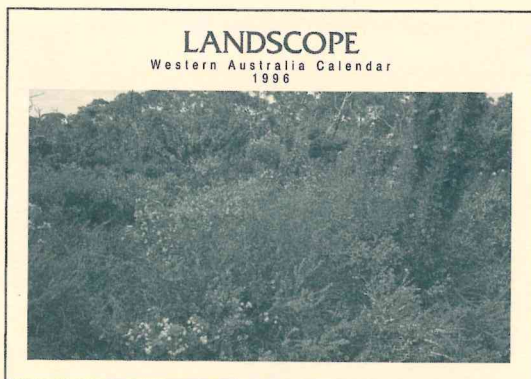

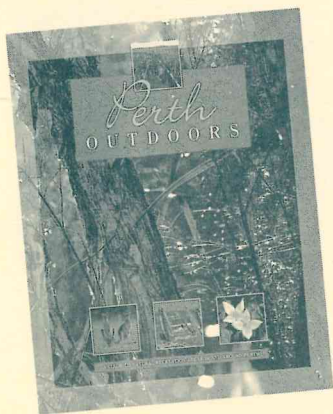

Family Walks in Perth Outdoors

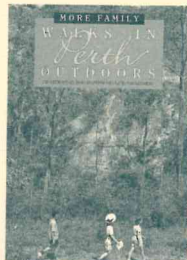
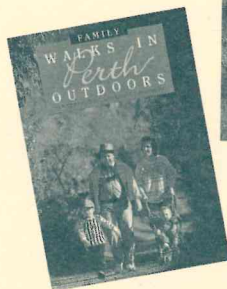
