IMPROVING THE FLOW

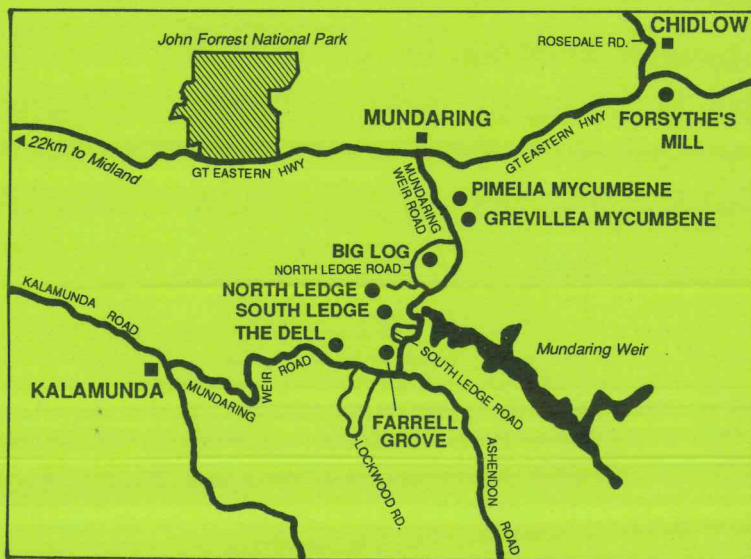
Traffic flow in John Forrest National Park will be improved when the present roadworks are completed.

CALM apologises for any inconvenience caused during reconstruction of the carparks and adjacent areas.

To provide better recreation sites, and to protect the natural environment from erosion and overuse, the number of carparks in some areas will be reduced.

Should the park be full, you can picnic at other CALM sites such as Forsythe's Mill (15-20kms further east along Great Eastern Highway) or those along Mundaring Weir Road.
