1. GROUND COVERS/CREEPERS

- +# Canavalia mauritiana: seabean good for coastal sandy areas, mauve flowers.
- # Combretum paniculatum: Flame creeper orange flowered climber.
- +# Ipomoea pes-caprae: Morning glory use as a ground cover or climber, mauve flowers.



Lippia nodiflora: Lippia - ground hugging, densely matted cover.

Lobelia quadrangularis: Kimberley Lobelia - ground cover, mauve flowers.

2. SHRUBS

- * Acacia arida: Hardy yellow flowers, fine foliage, to 1 m.
- * Acacia exilis: Yellow flowers, full sun, to 1 m. 🔌
- * Acacia hilliana: Very low spreading shrub, yellow flowers, to 0.5 m.

Acacia hippuroides: Very decorative shrub to 1 m, prolific flowerer, yellow flowers.

- * Acacia translucens: Compact shrub, yellow flowers, to 1m
- # Callistemon viminalis: Weeping bottle brush to 5 m.

Cassia alata: 2 m, candlestick cassia, yellow a "candlestick" flowers.

Cassia chatelainiana: to 1.5 m, compact rounded shrub, fine foliage, yellow flowers

* *Cassia helmsii*: to 1.5 m, grey foliage, yellow flowers, compact.

Cassia magnifolia: to 1.5 m, glossy green foliage, yellow flowers.

- # Petalostylis labicheoides: 2 m, quick growing open shrub, yellow flowers.
- # *Templetonia hookeri*: 2 m, fine weeping foliage, yellow flowers.

3. SMALL TREES

- *+ Acacia ampliceps: 5 m, salt tolerant, glossy green foliage, cream flowers.
- Acacia coriacea: 5 m, weeping habit, green/grey slender foliage.

Acacia dunnii: 5 m, elephant ear wattle, large grey leaves, masses of yellow flowers, decorative.

Acacia gracillima: 4 m, fine foliage, yellow flowers, weeping habit.



Acacia jensenii: 3 m, rounded, compact small tree, yellow flowers.



Acacia trachycarpa: 4 m, dense glossy foliage, good wind break material, yellow flowers.

Grevillea pteridifolia: 6-7 m, slender tree, fine foliage, bright orange "hairbrush flowers", bird attractive.



Hakea macrocarpa: 5-6 m, large creamy-white flowers on slender tree.

Leptospermum longifolium: 4 m, weeping ti-tree, attractive, can be shaped or pruned.

4. ORNAMENTAL SHADE TREES

Adansonia gregorii: Boab tree to 15 m - occasionally 4 available.

- # Adenanthera pavoniana: Indian bead tree to 8 m.
- +# Albizia lebbeck: Sirrus tree, quick growing to 15 m.
- # Alstonia scholaris: Cheesewood to 12 m. Calophyllum inophyllum: beauty leaf - spreading tree to 15 m, fragrant flowers.
- +# Casuarina equisitifolia: Coastal sheoak to 8m.

Cathormion umbellatum: Cathormium tree, to 10 m, yellow flowers.

- # Conocarpus erectus: Buttonwood quick growing shade tree to 15 m, good for coastal conditions.
- + Cordia sebastina: Orange trumpet flowers, tree to 6 m.
- # Eucalyptus argillacea Northern grey box rough bark, blue/grey foliage, to 10 m.
- # *E. aspera*: Brittle range gum white bark, to 8 m.
- # *E. bigalerita*: Northern salmon gum smooth bark, broad glossy leaves, 10 m.
- # *E. brevifolia*: Snappy gun smooth bark, small blue/grey leaves, to 8 m.
- +# *E. camaldulensis*: River red gum smooth bark, long shiny leaves to 25 m.

E. collina: Silver leaf bloodwood - mottled bark, silver foliage to 15 m.

- # E. coolabah: Coolibah tree smooth bark, very hardy to 8 m.
 - *E. cupularis*: Halls Creek white gum smooth bark, long leaves to 8 m.

E. herbertiana: Kalumburu white gum - smooth bark, ornamental tree to 8 m.





E. jensenii: Wandi ironbark - thick plated bark, blue foliage to 10 m.

- # *E. microtheca*: Northern coolibah rough bark, weeping foliage, to 10 m.
- # E. papuana: Ghost gum smooth bark, spreading crown to 10 m.
- # E. patellaris: Weeping box fibrous bark, grey/green foliage, to 10 m.
- # E. terminalis: Inland bloodwood mottled bark, very a hardy to 10 m.
- # Ficus racemosa: River fig broad spreading crown to 15m.
- # Gmelina arborea: Snapdragon tree quick growing to 20 m.
- # Khaya senegalensis: African mahogany bushy crown, 15 m.

Lophostemon grandiflorus: Freshwater mangrove - quick and growing fragrant flowers, termite resistant, to 10 m.

- # Lysiphyllum cunninghamii: Native bauhinia - compact bush, red flowers to 6 m.
- # Melaleuca argentea: Silver leaf paperbark, to 10 m.
- .# M. dealbata: Blue leaf paperbark broad crown, to 10 m.

- Mimusops elengi: Medlar tree good coastal species to 8 m.

Nauclea orientalis: Leichhardt pine - very broad leaves, 20 m.

Peltophorum pterocarpum: Yellow flame tree - colourful shade, 15 m.

Samanea saman: Darwin rain tree - huge broad a spreading tree, 30 m.

- # Sesbania formosa: Corkwood red and white flowered varieties, 8 m.
- +# Tamarindus indicus: Tamarind Tree termite resistant, 25 m.
- +# Terminalia catappa: Malay almond shady layered tree, 15 m.-
- +# T. petiolaris: Blackberry tree shady coastal tree to 10 m.
