5. Where possible orders will be grouped in customer lots and delivered to Shire Offices or other locations as arranged, within the Narrogin delivery area.
6. Orders taken from outside the delivery area must be either
 - a. Collected from the Nursery.
 - b. Delivered to within the delivery area.
 - c. Client to pay freight

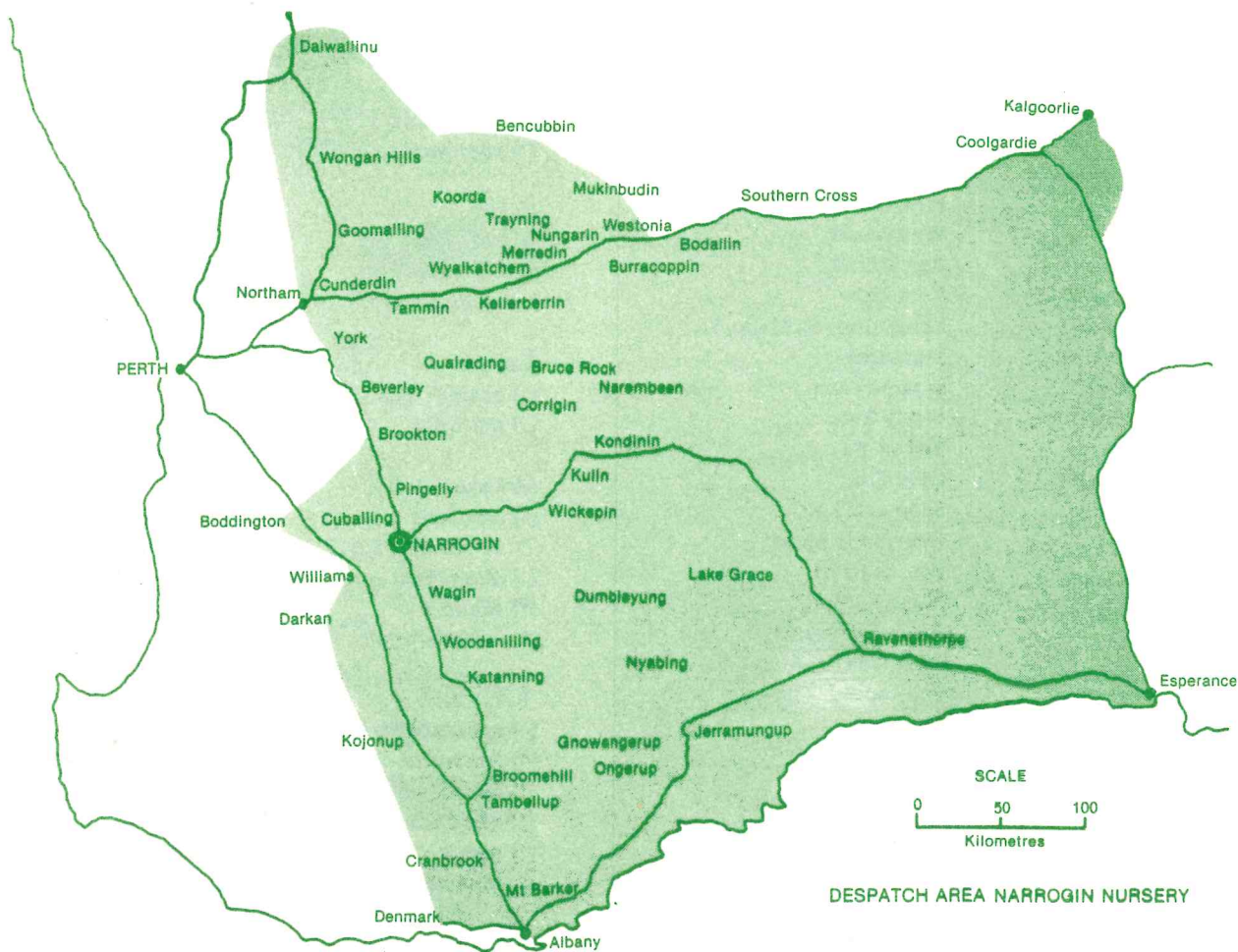
