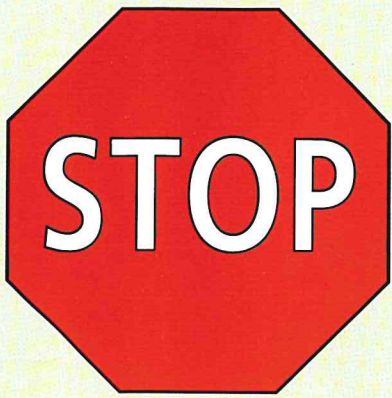


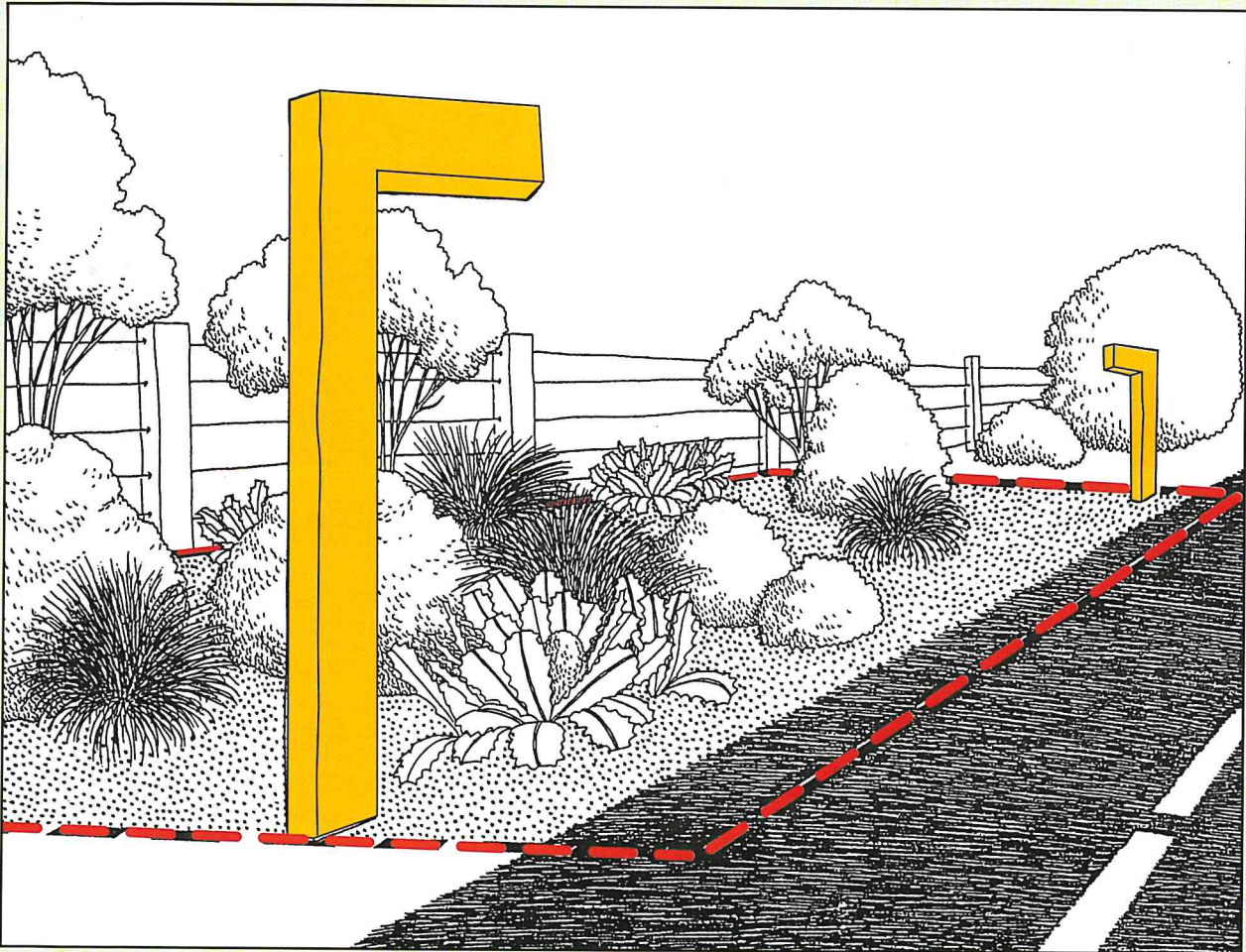

ENVIRONMENTALLY SIGNIFICANT SITE



These yellow 'hockey-stick' markers are placed at either end of an environmentally significant site to protect threatened flora. The markers point inwards towards the site.
