6. ORNAMENTAL SHADE TREES

Hakea species, small trees to 4m., spikes of cream flowers.

Hibiscus tilliaceous, unusual medium size tree to 7m., large leaves.

Instia bijuga, Muluccan ironwood, tree to 10m., with valuable timber.

Khaya senegalensis, African mahogany to 15m., evergreen.

Gmelina arborea, snapdragon tree to 20m., quick growing.

Lysiphyllum cunninghamii, native bauhinia, attractive red flowers.

Melaleuca argentea, silver leaf cadjeput to 10m. Melaleuca leucadendron, paperbark tree to 15m. Mimusops elengii. Medlar tree to 8m.

Moringa pterygosperma, curry leaf tree to 8m. Nauclea coadunatus, Leichhardt pine to 20m. Samanea saman, rain tree to 20m.

Schotia brachypetala, red flowering tree to 10m. Sesbania formosa, corkwood tree, very quick growing to 12m.

Thespesia populnea, cottonwood, ideal for coastal plantings, to 9m.

Thevitia peruviana, small tree, very hardy, yellow flowers.

Terminalia arostrata, weeping nutwood to 8m. T. catappa, Malay almond, hardy, attractive, to 15m.

T. petiolaris, native blackberry to 10m.
T. species, as seed comes to hand many of these sought after varieties will become available.

Conditions of Sale

The Broome Nursery is a tree nursery growing hardy native and exotic trees suitable for the semi-arid tropics. Householders are entitled to 12 free plants once only and commercial and horticultural blocks 20 free plants once only. All free plants are transported free of charge to Airlines of W.A. destinations through the courtesy of Ansett Air Freight. Additional plants are available from \$1.00 each and are sent freight forward.

Community projects, shires, schools, aboriginal communities etc. are entitled to free plants. Requests should specify exactly what the plants are required for.

1. EUCALYPTS

Eucalyptus bigalerita, northern salmon gum to 10m

E. camaldulensis, river red gum to 30m

E. patellaris, weeping box gum to 20m

E. papuana, ghost gum to 9m

E. ptychocarpa, spring bloodwood to 10m E. cupularis, Halls Creek white gum to 9m

E. brevifolia, northern white gum to 11m

E. pruinosa, silver box to 7m

E. socialis, Tom Price redwood mallee to 4m

2. PALMS

Carpentaria acuminata, Carpentaria palm to 8m tall and narrow

Livistona species, northern native palms 3m to 7m Sabal minor, a very hardy dwarf palm to 3m Beaucarnea recurvata, hardy ponytail palm to 10m -\$3.00 ea.

Washingtonia filifera, cotton palm to 12m Phoenix dactylifera, date palm to 8m

3. SHRUBS

Cassia species, shrubs from 1m to 3m., all bushy with yellow flowers, hardy and quick growing, 5 different species.

Acacia species, wattles, all northern native shrubs from 2m to 4m., drought resistant, lemon, white and yellow flowering, 15 different species.

Callistemon viminalis, weeping bottlebrush to 5m., best kept as a shrub.

Callistemon rigidus, bottlebrush to 2m., red flowers. Gossupium species, hibiscus family to 2m., with mauve flowers.

Leptospermum brachyandrum, topical ti-tree to

Grevillea species, various as seed comes to hand, to

Melaleuca species, various as seed comes to hand.

4. CLIMBERS AND GROUND COVERS

Ipomoea braziliensis, used as ground cover or climber, mauve flowers.

Native species (as seed supply and material come to hand, quantities vary from season to season).

Canavalea mauritiana, sea bean. Good for sandy

coastal areas.

Nyctanthes arbor-tristis, night jasmine. Climber or sprawling shrub. Flowers white.

5. FRUITING TREES AND SHRUBS

Anacardium occidentalis, cashew nut tree. Ornamental tree with an edible vitamin filled apple, the nut is toxic until treated; hardy, salt tolerant to 12m.

Citrus aurantifolia, West Indian lime to 7m. High in vitamin C.

Fortunella japonica, Kalamansi cumquat to 12m., very hardy.

Psidium quajava, quava, a shrub to 6m., hardv, high in vitamin C.

Spondias cythera, golden apple to 15m – \$3.00 ea. Tamarindus indica, a tree to 25m., with edible fruits, termite resistant

Zizyphus mauritiana, Indian date, excellent drought tolerant tree to 10m.

Mangifera indica, mango tree to 25m., with 8m spread, very hardy.

Barringtonia acutangula, freshwater mangrove

B. trichosiphon, kurrajong to 8m. Pyramidical

Bixa orellana, lipstick bush. 3m to 4m.

Caesalpinia ferrea, Brazilian ironwood to 15m. Calophyllum inophyllum, Indian oil nut tree to

Cathormium umbellatum, tree to 10m with vellow flowers, good shade.

Cassia fistula, golden shower tree to 15m., hardy, attractive.

Casuarina equisetifolia, sheoak, ideal for sandy coastal conditions.

Dolichandrone heterophylla, lemonwood to 6m. Ficus racemosa, river fig to 15m. Gyrocarpus americanus, helicopter tree to 5m.
