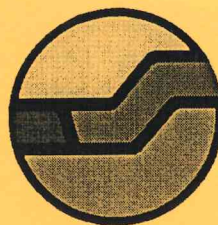

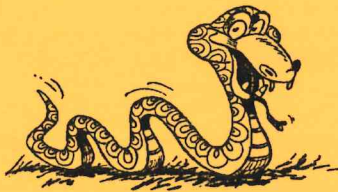
### 1. Nighttime Escapades

Join local CALM Officers in a nighttime exploration of the Woodland. Bring your torch and search for some of the many nocturnal critters found in the Woodland. Meet at Irabina Study Center.

### 2. Kids Corner
