HOW TO SEE The Avon Descent

- The access road (Quarry Road) is a two way road to the parking area at the old airstrip. You cannot proceed further as traffic is one way from the river.
- Please keep your speed below 60 km per hour and watch for oncoming traffic.
- There is a parking fee of \$9.00 per car or \$3.30 per passenger if arriving by bus. Proceeds go to the Gingin Chittering Lions Club.
- Free buses will take you to within 300m of the river.
- There is food and drink for sale at the parking area and near the river.
- Please do not litter. Take your rubbish home or use the bins provided.

Pets are NOT allowed in national parks, even if you intend to keep them in your vehicles.
