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# Pinnacles Desert Discovery

**The Pinnacles Desert Discovery is a unique and spectacular experience within Nambung National Park, 200km north of Perth.**

Rising mysteriously from the dune sands are thousands of limestone pillars up to 4m tall; a landscape in eerie contrast to the surrounding heath. Some are jagged, sharp-edged columns rising to a point; others resemble tombstones.

What exactly are the pinnacles? What natural processes created these odd and spectacular structures?

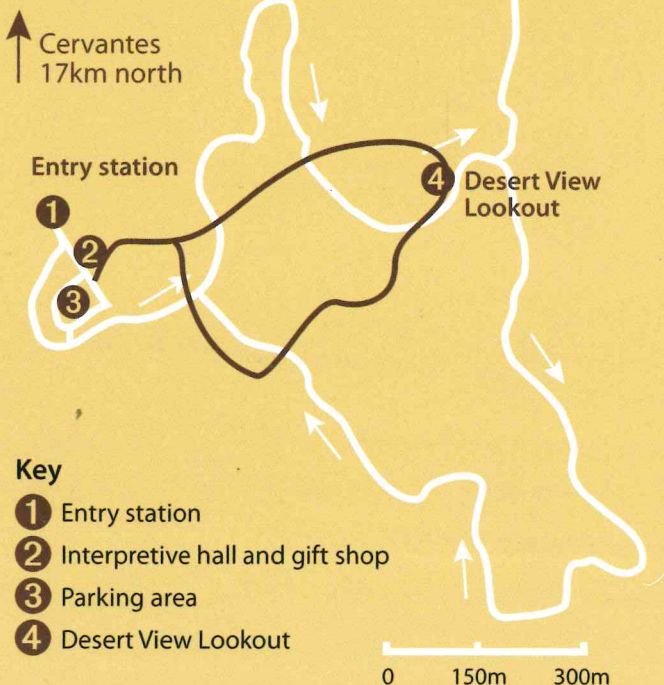


Pinnacles Desert Discovery interpretive hall
