



## The Kalbarri Skywalk is open!

Venture beyond the edge of a 100m drop for spectacular views over Kalbarri National Park.

Perched right on the cliff-top, two fabulous lookouts as well as undercover seating, toilets and connecting paths and walkways are safe and wheelchair accessible.



## **Visitor tips:**

- Park entry includes Kalbarri Skywalk.
   (\$15 per vehicle, \$8 concession)
- Buy park passes online, at the park or Kalbarri Visitor Centre. (\$25 for five days)
- Take a hat and drinking water. Mornings are best in hot weather
- Leave caravans and trailers in Kalbarri or unhitch at the entry station.
