To avoid causing inconvenience and discomfort to other visitors, dogs are not permitted in National Parks.

There are two basic rules where National Parks are concerned:—

Preserve the natural state of the Park by keeping your vehicle to approved roads and cks;

- —the wildflowers for others to enjoy;
- —peace and quiet for our animals and birds;
- —the rocks and earth formations from defacement.

Protect other visitors' enjoyment by driving gently and quietly; by putting all rubbish in the bins provided or by taking it home; by respecting the privacy of other picnickers and campers.


To help pay for the costs of caring for National Parks, fees are charged for the entry of vehicles and for camping. Ask the Ranger about Park attractions and hazards and campsites.

STIRLING RANGE




NATIONAL PARKS— WESTERN AUSTRALIA MAY 1976

When you are in a National Park, please drive slowly so that you can enjoy the scenery, appreciate the beauty and variety of the trees, the shrubs and the wildflowers, understand the earth building forces that made the land, see the animal and birdlife without frightening them away, and not spoil the enjoyment of the Park for other visitors.


When you see an interesting spot, stop the car and get out and walk. On foot you will see more, hear more and get more enjoyment from the natural values of the Park.

Walking, climbing, exploring, nature observation, and photography are activities which are inspired by and derive their enjoyment from the natural character and features of a National Park.

DESERT-NAMBUNG NATIONAL PARK



In appropriate areas, horse riding and quiet forms of boating also facilitate enjoyment of the natural values.

A National Park is not a scenic location for a golf course, amusement park or spectator sports events. It is not a place for playing with mechanical recreation vehicles such as fun bikes and beauth buggies. These recreational activities have their own built-in values and rewards and need not be enjoyed within a National Park. All vehicles in National Parks are required to keep to designated roads and tracks. Unlicensed vehicles are not permitted in the Parks.

A National Park is a place where all can get away from the pressures of modern living and relax in the peace of natural areas. For those who want to enjoy the
