Visitor fees apply at major national parks in Western Australia and passes are required where these fees apply.

The following passes are available for your convenience:

DAY PASS

\$9 per vehicle* or \$3.30 per bus passenger.

Motorcycles, Senior Card, Aged Pension and Department of Veterans' Affairs Card holders: \$3 per vehicle.

HOLIDAY PASS

\$22.50 per vehicle* - up to 4 weeks unlimited entry to all national parks.

ANNUAL LOCAL PARK PASS

\$17 per vehicle* – unlimited entry to one national park or a group of local parks.

ALL PARKS ANNUAL PASS

\$51 per vehicle* - unlimited entry to all national parks for one year.

GOLD STAR PASS

\$73 per vehicle* – combined All Parks Annual Pass with an annual subscription to *LANDSCOPE* magazine.

All prices include GST. Park passes are not valid for the Valley of the Giants, Monkey Mia and Penguin Island.


