

WHERE ARE WE?

Dwellingup is an historic timber town nestled in the jarrah forest, only 20 minutes inland from Pinjarra, 40 minutes from Mandurah and an easy 90-minute drive from Perth.

ACCOMMODATION

The Jarrah Forest Lodge has all the features you'd expect in a timber town—wooden floors and wood fires. Accommodation is simple, but clean and comfortable. Rooms open on to wide verandahs overlooking gardens and an open gazebo. Sixteen heated, single, bunk and double bedrooms are available. (You need to bring your own bedding). Cooking, washing and bathroom facilities are shared. There's also a great heated recreation room for late night chats or group activities.
