The Forest Heritage Centre is located in Dwellingup, a historic timber town nestled in the jarrah forest, only 20 minutes inland from Pinjarra, 40 minutes from Mandurah and an easy 90-minute drive from Perth.

Natural highlights close by

- North and South Dandalup dams offer breathtaking views and serviced picnic area.
- The Lane Poole Reserve along the Murray River has many special picnic and camping areas all focused along this scenic river.
- The Marrinup forest tour links the Marrinup Falls walktrail, the Prisoner of War Camp, and the Oakley Dam picnic site right on the Darling Scarp.
