The Broome Nursery supplies hardy native and exotic trees suitable for growing in the Kimberley & Pilbara regions.

Residents are entitled to free plants on a once only basis.

Householders: 12 plants

Commercial Blocks: 20 plants.

All free plants are transported free of charge via Ansett Air Freight (southward) or Comet (northward).

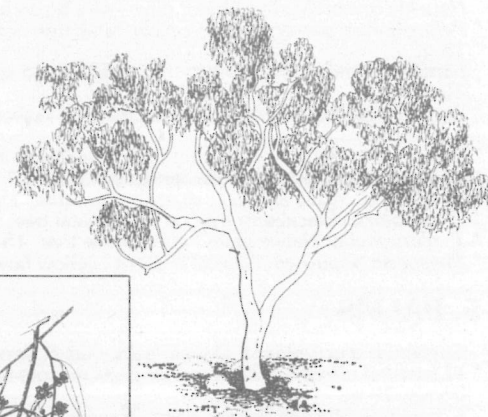
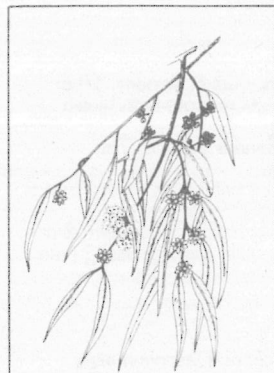
Additional plants can be purchased - prices start at \$1.00 ea. according to species.

Purchased plants are sent freight forward on the most suitable carrier.

Applications for free plants for community projects will be considered upon receipt of a written request.

If plants requested are unavailable, substitutes will be selected.

For large orders, please allow a minimum of 4 months for completion of order.

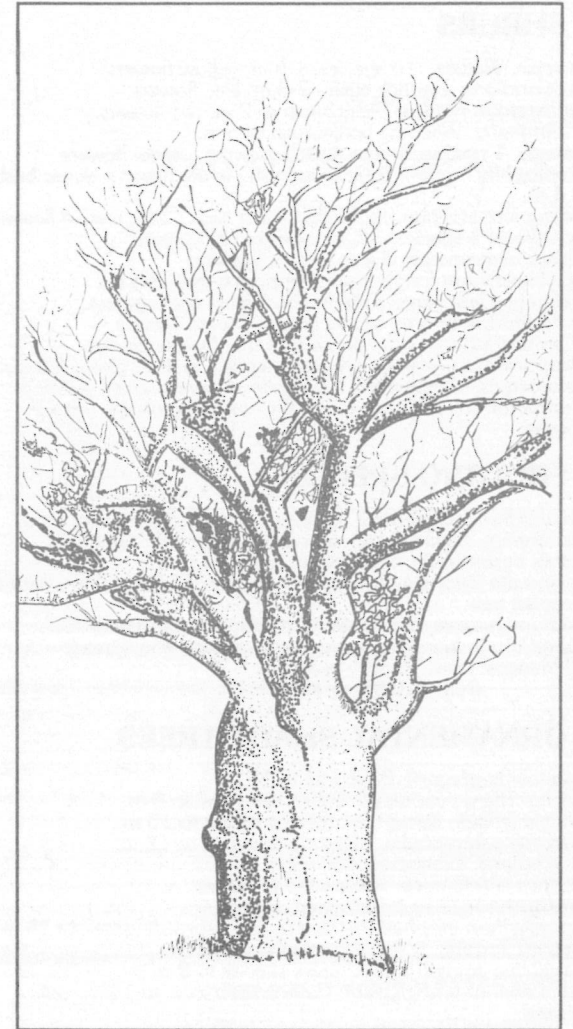


E. brevifolia: Snappy gum
