BRANCH RESTRUCTURING: INFORMATION AND RECREATION AND LANDSCAPE BRANCHES

An internal functional review has been undertaken of our Information Branch (which comprised Publications, Media Relations, Advisory Services, Community Education, displays and counter/switchboard staff at State Operations Headquarters) and Recreation and Landscape Branch.

A reorganisation has resulted.

Under the new arrangements, there will continue to be two independent groups, but their responsibilities will be reallocated.

The groups will be called the Public Affairs Branch; and Recreation, Landscape and Community Education Branch.

The Public Affairs Branch will comprise Publications and Media Relations. It will be located at Crawley and come under the direct control of the Executive Director.

The Recreation, Landscape and Community Education Branch will comprise recreation planning, research and design, landscape and community education. It will be located at Como and fall within the Technical Services Division.

Rural advisory officers and regional information officers will report to regional managers, and counter and switchboard staff at State Operations Headquarters will become part of the General Manager's group.

The proposed branch structures and dispersal of staff are shown on the attached.

Transfer of Mr Goss to Soil Conservation Commissioner's Staff.

Many staff will have heard already that Kevin Goss has been offered and has accepted a position with the Department of Agriculture's Division of Resource Management. It is a job directly concerned with new soil conservation initiatives and well suited to Kevin's expertise and experience. I am sorry to see him leave CALM and offer him best wishes in his new job.
