Name "Ord River Regeneration Reserve" (unofficial name)

RESERVE No. 28538, adjoining Purnululu National Park

REASON FOR ACTION

Creation of a new reserve, Reserve 28538, adjoining Purnululu National Park, in the Shire of Halls Creek. **Area:** 575,554.0 ha. **Class:** unclassified. **Purpose:** Regeneration of Eroded Areas in Ord River Dam Catchment. **Management Order:** Executive Director of the Department of Conservation and Land Management (with power to lease for any term not exceeding O* years subject to the consent of the Minister for Lands).

The reserve was established in 1967 from resumed land that had been degraded, following years of overstocking by the pastoral industry, and additional grazing from feral donkeys and camels. The main areas affected were those associated with the Ord River; most other land systems remain largely intact. A management order was later issued to the Chief Executive Officer of the Department of Agriculture. The reserve is of high value to conservation in including a number of ecosystems poorly represented or unrepresented elsewhere in the conservation estate.

Discussions between the Department of Agriculture and the then Department of Conservation and Land Management (CALM) resulted in the transfer of vesting to the Executive Director of CALM.

AT a Meeting of the Executive Council held in the Executive Council Chambers, at Perth, this 3rd day of March, 1987, the following Orders in Council were authorised to be issued:

Local Government Act 1960
ORDER IN COUNCIL

L. & S. Corres. 2949/985.

WHEREAS by section 288 of the Local Government Act 1960, it shall be lawful for the Governor, on request by a Council of a Municipal District, by Order published in the *Government Gazette* to declare any lands reserved or acquired for use by the public or used by the public as a street, way, public place, bridge or thoroughfare, under the care, control, and management of the Council, or lands comprised in a private street, constructed and maintained to the satisfaction of the Council, or lands comprised in a private street of which the public has had uninterrupted use for a period of not less than 10 years, as a public street and if the Council thinks fit, that the Governor shall declare the width of the carriageway and footpaths of the public street. And whereas the Town of Cottesloe has requested that certain lands named and described in the schedule hereunder, which have been reserved for a street within its municipal district be declared a public street.

Now, therefore, The Lieutenant Governor and Deputy of the Governor by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby declare the said lands to be a public street, and such land shall, from the date of this Order, be absolutely dedicated to the public as a street within the meaning of any law now or hereafter in force.

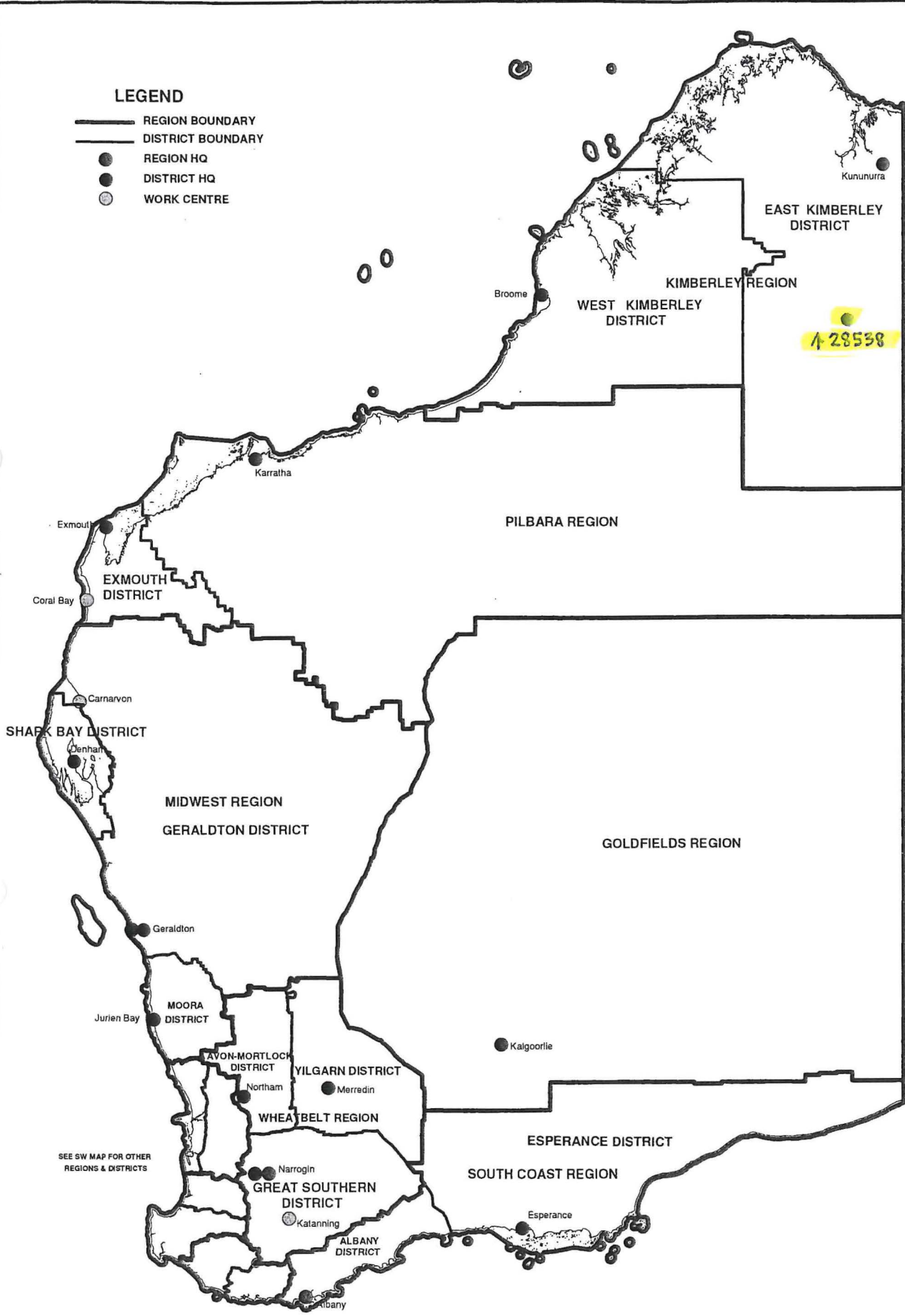

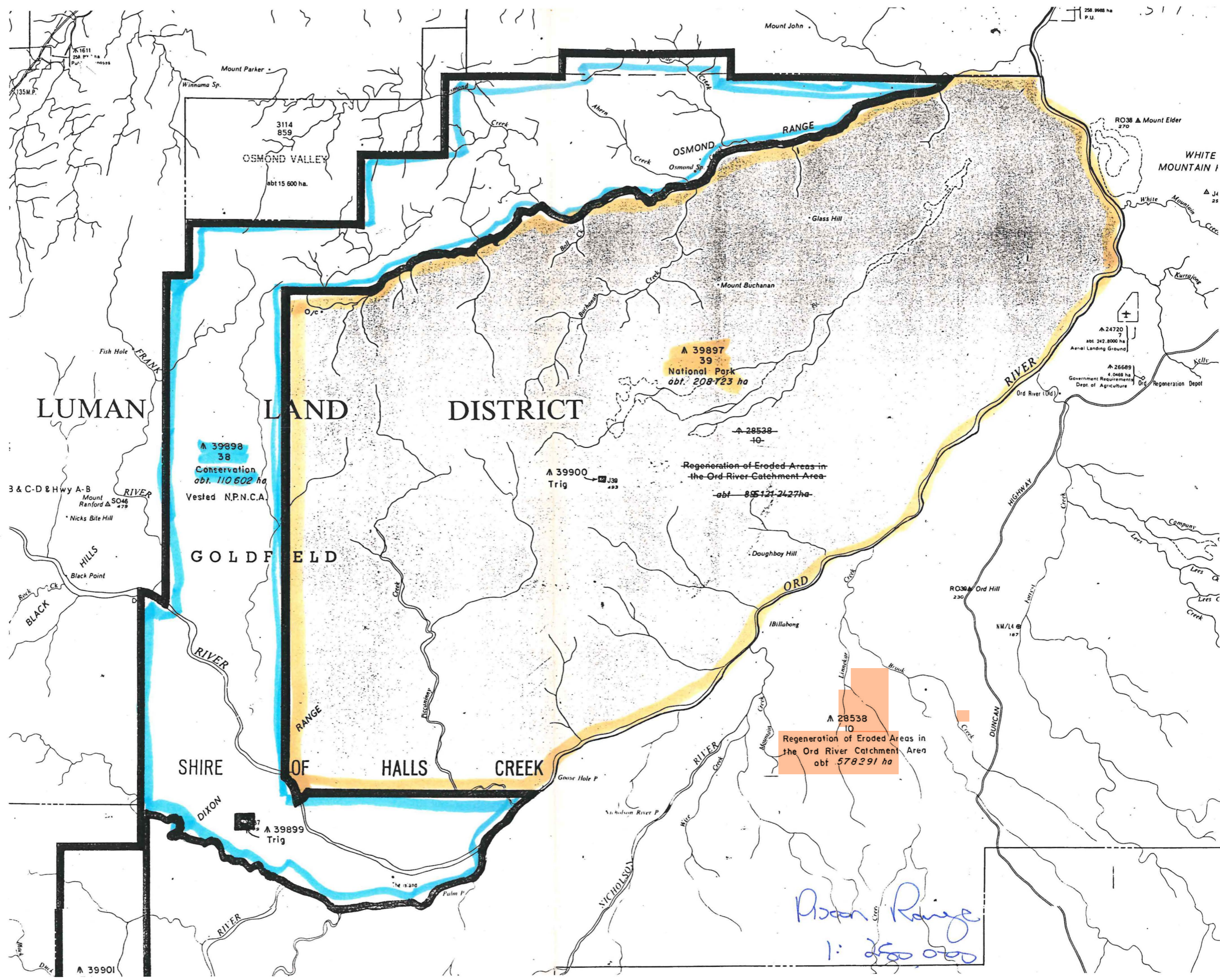
