

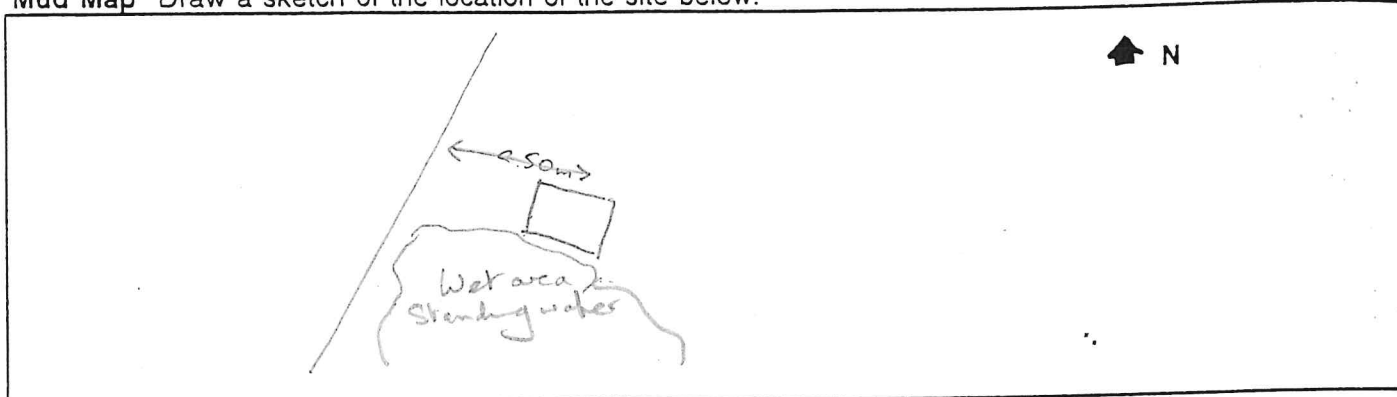

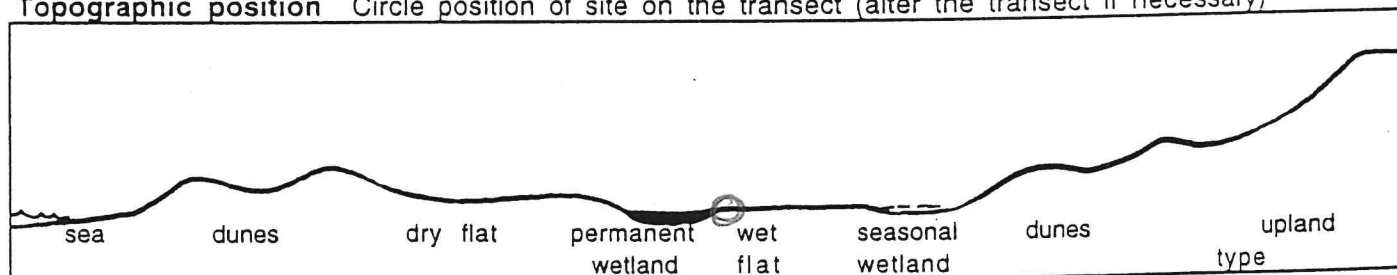


Road Location N of main Thundellara Road thru Bunaburnah
