

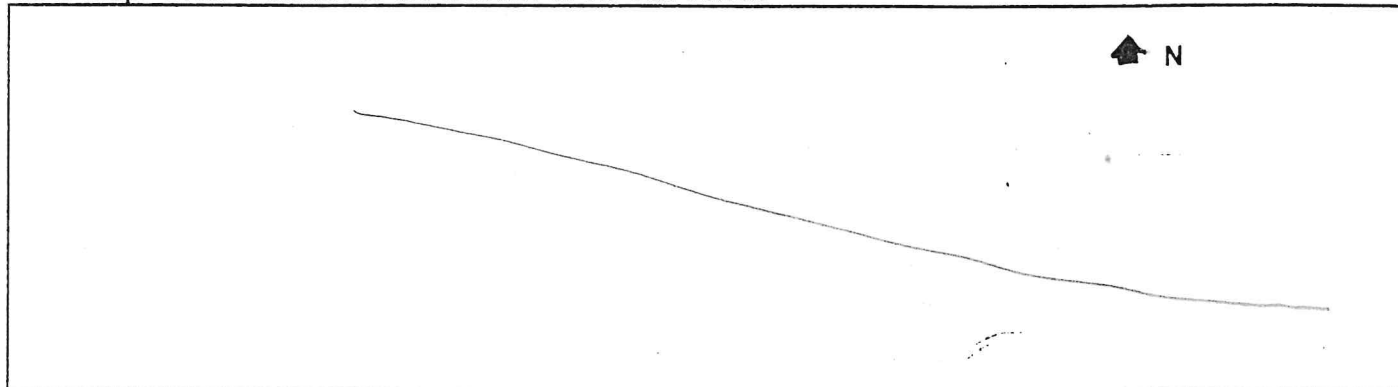

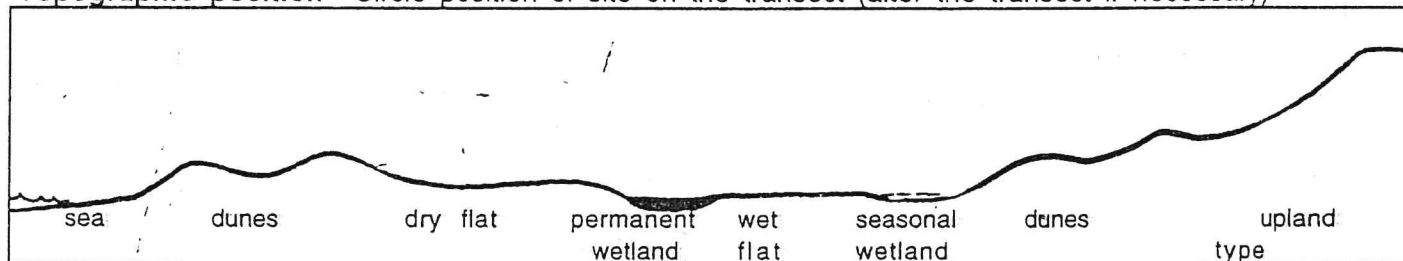


Road Location Boundary of Wadgee
