NWS SHIPPING THEATRE



To add that unique touch to your event, talk to the functions team about arranging a special after hours viewing of the most exciting museum affoat!







Internet access

3G wireless network operates throughout Perth. Plan is now to purchase 4 or 5 Ericsson w25 wireless hubs, wireless at both ends, currently at 3.6 mbps but upgradeable to 7.2 mbps or more

Power for laptops

Power strips and extension cables will be available in the auditorium and each break-out room. All cables will be taped to prevent a trip hazard

Projection facilities

The main plenary venue has integrated digital LCD projector run from the main podium. Portable LCD projectors will be used in the breakout rooms

Sound

The auditorium has a fully integrated sound system from the podium and roving microphone
