Report on the Extent of Works

All steel verandah framing has been replaced with cadjeput (paper bark) log columns, beams and hips. The verandah roofing and the lean-to roofing over the store has been re-sheeted with new corrugated iron. All doors and shutters were replaced with ledged and braced timber doors and shutters. A termite eaten column at the rear of the stove was replaced. New louvre ventilation panels and framework were installed in the gable ends. A hessian ceiling was installed in the dining room in lieu of the original tar paper which could not be procured. Internal walls of the kitchen and store were white washed. Spot lighting was installed for future display purposes. The building was treated for termites.

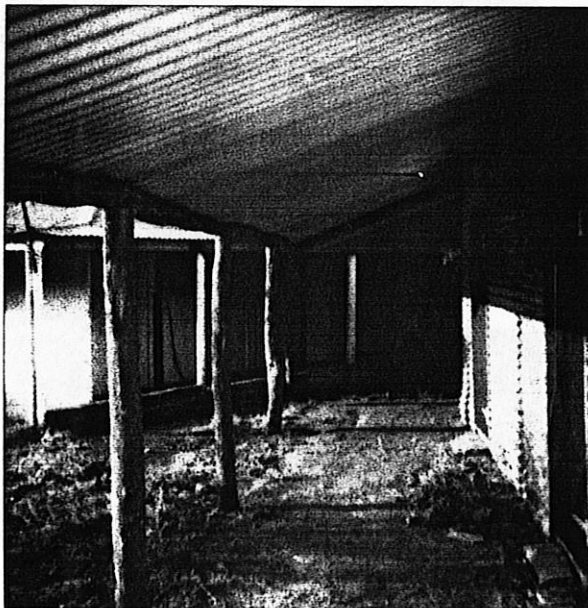
Costs totalled \$14630.00

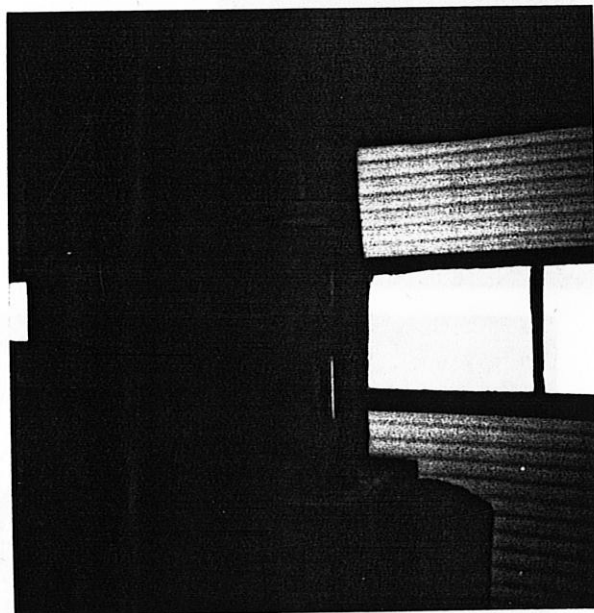
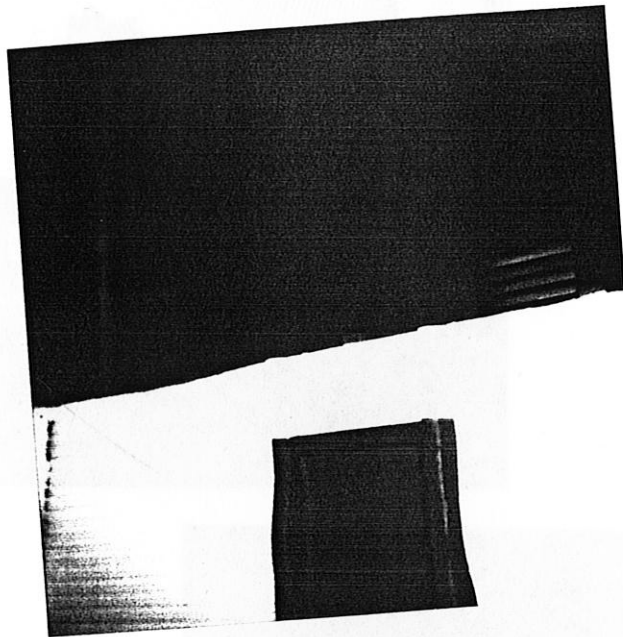
Old Kitchi Mellisham Homestead.
