MARINE RESERVE IMPLEMENTATION PILBARA

HUMAN USAGE IN MONTEBELLO/ BARROW ISLANDS

Data Report: MRI/PI/MBI - 36/2000

A collaborative project between CALM Marine Conservation Branch, CALM Karratha Regional Office.

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1 INTRODUCTION

The Montebello/Barrow Islands region has been selected by the state government for consideration as a marine conservation reserve under the CALM Act. The region was selected after being identified in the report, *A Representative Marine Reserve System for Western Australia* (CALM 1994) as an area worthy of reservation. To assist in the planning process, data have been gathered on the human activities currently undertaken in the study area (Figure 1). This report presents the spatial boundaries and intensities of various human activities, including recreation and industrial activities, as of December 1999. The human usage data are being continually updated for the marine reserve planning process and the data presented in this report were the first attempt by CALM at data collection for the study area. The updated data are on the Marine Conservation Branch database. The human usage data has been used in the report *Regional Perspective of Montebello/Barrow Islands* (CALM 2000).

2 SOURCES & METHODS

Data was collected based on the general list in Table 1, which lists required socio-cultural datasets for management of marine parks. All data except the recreational and tourism data were taken from existing digital datasets from government departments. A summary of data availability is shown in Table 2.

Digital data were clipped to the extent of the study area and the projection and datum adjusted as necessary. Table 3 shows the source of each dataset and the source filename. The filename of the modified data is also given, which allows it to be traced within the CALM directory structure. Rows that are left blank indicate that data are not available at this time.

Andrew Hill of CALM consulted with Montebello Safaris to document moorings and campsites on the islands. Surfing and SCUBA diving sites in the study area were also identified.

The recreational fishing and tourism data were gathered using the following process:

Step 1. Fisheries WA provided a digital dataset of fishing usage around Montebello, Lowendal and Barrow Islands. This could not be made public as it was not gathered from a consultative process.

Step 2. The Pilbara Recreational Fishing Advisory Committee was consulted, and their advice was that most recreational fishing in the area took place through the commercial tour operators.

Step 3. Letters were sent to seven tour operators that operate in the Montebello Island area requesting spatial data of their activities. The letters were sent to:

Step 4. At the time this report was published only three tourist operators had responded with information. Their data have been summarised in Figure 13.

The spatial data is stored in this report and within the Marine Conservation Branch spatial database.
