1. Targeted survey *Banksia serratuloides* subsp *perissa* Alex Morrison NP.
2. Investigation of clearing of full pop. of *Darwinia acerosa* and
3. Gained access to private property for flora survey for possible pops of *D.acerosa*.
4. RFRFs for ~20 species.
5. New pop *Haloragis platycarpa* found at Koojan.

Weed control at *Acacia cochlocarpa* subsp. *cochlocarpa* translocation and natural pops of *Eremophila scaburela*, repair fencing at *Grevillea calliantha* translocation. Changed all retic in all translocations from 40mm poly pipe to 19mm retic pipe with massive improvement in watering
