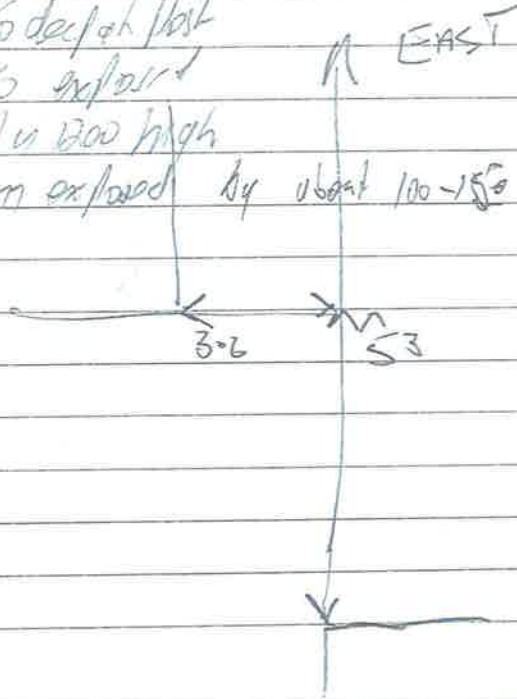

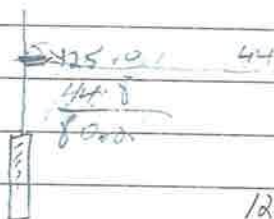

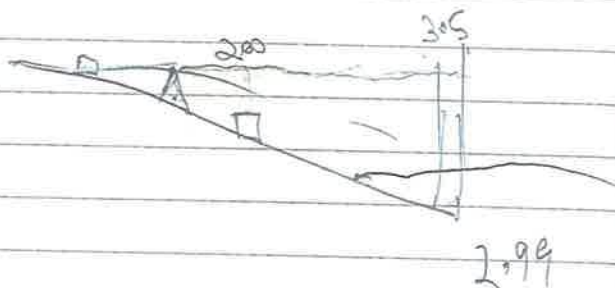

The Park of the arranged preparations for
fire control on the Woodland where known
it is planned to reduce the fuel
load in strategic areas of the bushland.

Following the wildfire in January 2001
Fire control officers expressed concern for
the safety of residents and fire fighters
when confronted by high fuel loads such
as those along the eastern boundary
of the reserve.
