

2. **BUCHANANIA**, Roxb.

ANACARDIACEAE

Flowers hermaphrodite. Calyx short, obtusely 3- to 5-toothed. Petals 5, imbricate in the bud. Disk orbicular, crenate. Stamens 10, inserted round the disk. Gynoecium of 5 or 6 distinct carpels, of which one only perfect, the others rudimentary and style-like; style of the perfect one short, with a truncate stigma; ovule suspended from an erect filiform funicle. Drupe small, the putamen crustaceous or bony, 2-valved. Seed with thick cotyledons and a superior radicle.—Trees. Leaves alternate, simple, entire, coriaceous. Flowers small, white, in terminal or axillary panicles.

The genus extends over tropical Asia and the islands of the Pacific, the Australian species having also a wide Asiatic range.
