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- Three key findings:
 - People like the planning framework but are either not using it, or are using it selectively
 - People embrace public participation / community involvement as a concept, but not planning it
 - o People see the manual as a great reference but are not referring to it
- 2/3 have referred to the manual since putting it on the shelf
- 1/4 use the planning framework reasonably vigorously
- 1/4 use the framework partly or loosely
- 20% use the framework vigorously
- Most people (85%) are still doing public participation
- Communication techniques such as verbal judo were still rolling out
- Customised course developed by International Association for Public Participation
- Dept of Environment consulted to produce facilitation toolkit "Working More Effectively with Groups"
- Snapshots of initiatives:

 - Consultation for biodiversity strategy
 - o New consultation technique via "Have Your Say" brochure
