In-water humpback whale interaction

In order to minimise both risks to visitors and disturbance to whales the following interaction protocol applies when swimming with humpback whales within Ningaloo Marine Park and Muiron Islands Marine Management Area.

Vessel operators are required to abide by additional rules that outline approach and departure instructions for humpback whale interactions.

Only operators licensed to participate in the 'In-water humpback whale interaction in Ningaloo Marine Park trial' are allowed to provide the opportunity to swim with humpback whales as part of a commercial tour. Recreational boaters are not allowed to swim with the humpback whales.

No approach zone

In-water humpback whale interactions are not permitted in the Commonwealth waters of Ningaloo Marine Park.
