An Act to amend Section Forty-two of the  
*Game Act 1928.*

**B**E it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Game Act 1930* and shall be read and construed as one with the *Game Act 1928* which Act and this Act may be cited together as the *Game Acts*.

2. Sub-section (1) of section forty-two of the *Game Act 1928* is hereby amended as follows:—

(a) In paragraph (e), before the words “native game” there shall be inserted the words “(whether taken or killed or destroyed in Victoria or elsewhere)”; and

(b) In paragraphs (h) and (i), after the word “opossums” there shall be inserted the words “(whether taken or killed or destroyed in Victoria or elsewhere).”
