activities to native animal and



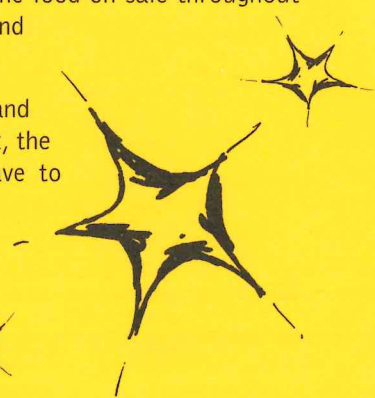
aerial water bombing displays. As the sun sets, the fun
