

Guidelines for tree establishment

- Select the correct species for your area and soil type. If in doubt, consult CALM's Tree Growers Information Kit.
- Control rabbits early in the season.
- Fence out the planting site prior to planting.
- Rip and, if necessary, mound the site well in advance of planting.
- Ensure good weed control using either chemical or mechanical means. If using chemical, incorporate a residual into the mix.
- Plant at the optimal time for the site, ie high sandy sites early wet low lying sites late.
- Make sure the seedling is planted to the correct depth and is well heeled in.
- Always transport plants in covered vehicles to prevent wind damage to the seedlings.
- Keep seedlings damp at all times prior to planting.




