

# Disabled access to the Observatory

Generous assistance from the Perth Observatory Volunteer Group and LotteryWest facilitated the acquisition of a telescope that can be easily manoeuvred to provide a view of the stars while providing easy access to suit viewers of different ability. PLEASE TELL THE STAFF ABOUT YOUR PARTICULAR NEEDS AT THE TIME OF BOOKING SO THAT THE APPROPRIATE FACILITIES CAN BE MADE READY FOR YOUR VISIT.

The Observatory buildings are also accessible to the disabled via a ramp. Another facility is the Observatory sky camera, which can be accessed through the Observatory website, and gives a current view of the sky overhead in Perth, and will be trained on objects of interest as they occur.



### **Daytime guided tours**

Tour the Observatory grounds, inspect modern and historic telescopes, view sunspots on the Sun (weather and time permitting) and enjoy a Highlights of the Universe computer presentation with expert commentary.

These tours are mainly for groups of 20 or more, but applications from smaller groups will be considered subject to staff and time availability.
