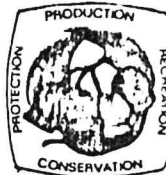


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FORESTS DEPARTMENT ARBORETUM

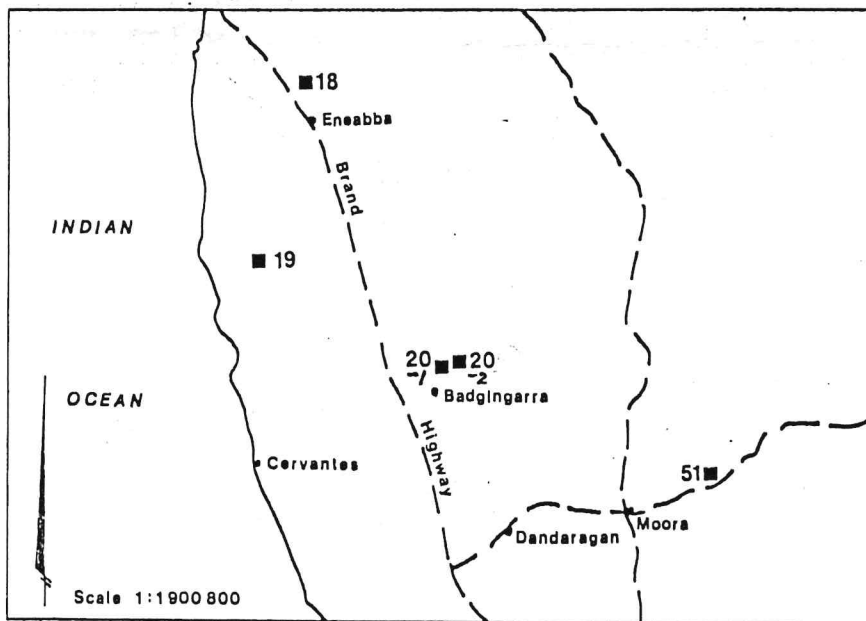


Welcome to BADGINGARRA arboretum: number 20 in a series of over 50 tree plots in the south-west.

Trees in this plot were established in the 1960's to assess the growth and performance of a variety of trees under local climatic and soil conditions. There are of course other species that could be tried.

The plan shows a general layout of the plot, and a key to both common and scientific names is provided.
