  - ❖ prizes

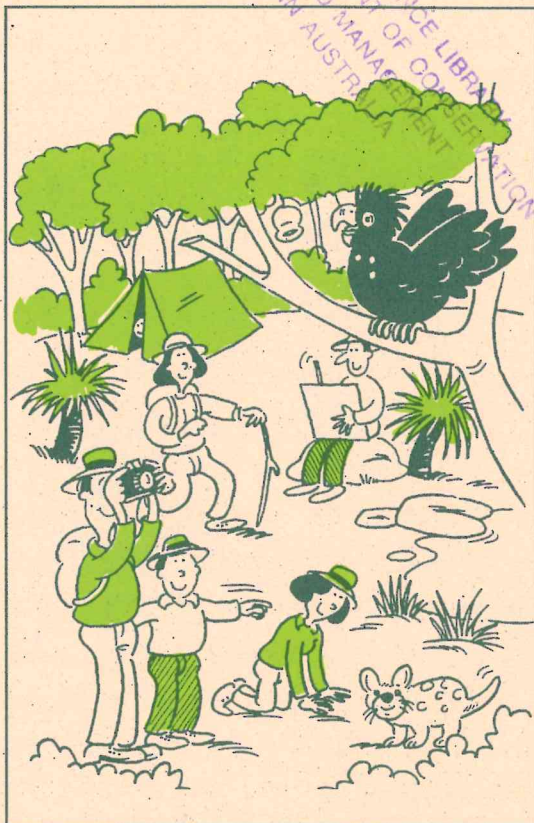
