6. The nursery reserves the right to supply a lesser number of trees than were ordered when the accompanying remittance is insufficient to cover the full value of the order.
7. A remittance made payable to the Department of Conservation and Land Management must accompany each order for trees. Postage stamps will be not be accepted.
8. Orders of less than 10 pots will not be delivered.
