

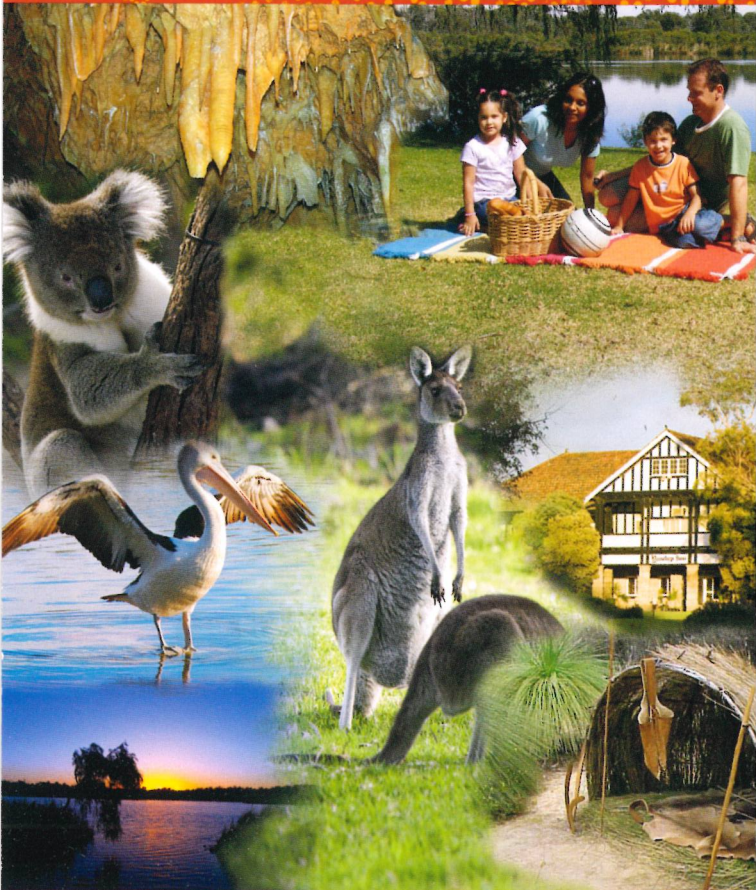

Yanchep National Park is 45 minutes drive from Perth CBD and open every day of the year. Entry and activity fees apply.

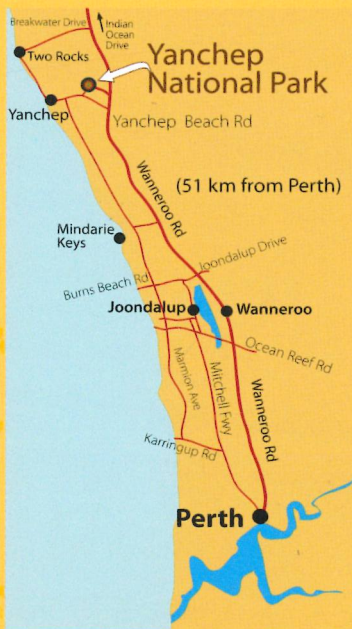
